[Question] What did Jesus then do after the Passover, and what kind of a lesson was this for his disciples?

2· No, but he emptied himself, and took a slave's form, and came to be in the likeness of men. (**Philippians 2:7**)

[Question] What did Jesus do upon finding himself upon the earth as a man?

3· Happy are those slaves whom the master on arriving, finds watching! Truly I say to you, he will gird himself and make them recline at the table, and will come alongside and minister to them. (**Luke 12:37**)

[Question] Who among Jesus' disciples did he show would be happy upon his return to the earth, and what would he then do for them?

4· For which one is greater, the one reclining at the table, or the one ministering? Is it not the one reclining at the table? But I am in your midst as the one ministering. (**Luke 22:27**)

[Question] Who did Jesus show was the greater, yet how did he act when among them?
