

**John 13:5~** After that he put water into a basin and started to wash the feet of the disciples, and to dry them off with the towel with which he was girded.

- 1· Then he proceeded to put some water in a basin, and he started to wash the feet of the disciples who were sitting there at the meal. Then Jesus would dry their feet off with the towel with which he was girded.

**[Question]** What did Jesus then do to all of his disciples who were sitting with him at the meal?

- 2· Let a little **water** be taken, please, and you must have your **feet** washed. Then, recline under the tree. (**Genesis 18:4**)

**[Question]** How did Abraham entertain the angels who visited him, as a gesture of hospitality and respect?

- 3· With that he turned to the woman and said to Simon; Do you behold this woman? I entered into your house, you gave me no **water** for my **feet**. But this woman wet my **feet** with her tears, and wiped them off with her hair. (**Luke 7:44**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell one Simon at whose house he went for a meal, for what happened while he was there?

- 4· Then he said; Yehowah, if, now, I have found favor in your eyes, please do not pass by your servant. (**Genesis 18:3**)

**[Question]** How did Abraham feel at the privilege of entertaining angels?

- 5· With that he brought him into his house and threw mash to the he-asses. Then they washed their **feet**, and began to eat and drink. (**Judges 19:21**)

**[Question]** How did an old man entertain those traveling in his area?

- 6· Immediately she rose up, and bowed with her face to the earth and said; Here is your slave girl as a maidservant to **wash the feet** of the servants of my lord. (**1 Samuel 25:41**)

**[Question]** How did Abigail show her respect for David and for his men, after her husband disrespected them?

- 7· **Having a witness borne to her for fine works, if she reared children, if she entertained strangers, if she washed the feet of holy ones, if she relieved those in tribulation, if she diligently followed every good work. (1 Timothy 5:10)**

**[Question]** What governed over whether a believing widow would be helped financially by the congregation of anointed Christians?
