

John 13:8~ Peter said to him; You will certainly never wash my feet. Jesus answered him; **Unless I wash you, you have no part with me.**

1· Peter however, inadvertently proving that what Jesus had said was correct, resisted Jesus doing this for him, saying; You will certainly never wash my feet. However Jesus responded, that unless he washed Peter's feet, that Peter would have no part with him.

[Question] What then, did Peter say to Jesus, and how did Jesus answer him?

2· Thoroughly **wash** me from my error, and cleanse me even from my sin. (**Psalms 51:2**)

[Question] What did the Psalmist ask of Yehowah God to do for him?

3· And yet that is what some of you were. But you **have** been washed clean, but you **have** been sanctified, but you **have** been declared righteous in the name of our Lord **Jesus** Christ, and with the spirit of our God. (**1 Corinthians 6:11**)

[Question] What were some anointed Christians, before becoming such, and how have their lives changed?

4· That he might sanctify it, cleansing it with the bath of water by means of the word. (**Ephesians 5:26**)

[Question] How are anointed Christians cleansed from bad works and wrong thinking?

5· Owing to no works in righteousness that we had performed, but according to his mercy, he saved us, through the bath that brought us to life, and through the making of us new, by Holy Spirit. (**Titus 3:5**)

[Question] How are anointed Christians saved from their former course in life and cleansed for godly service?

6· Let us approach with true hearts, in the full assurance of faith, having had our hearts sprinkled from a wicked conscience, and our bodies bathed with clean water. (**Hebrews 10:22**)

[Question] What have anointed Christians been sprinkled with, and how have they been bathed to become clean for God's service?
