

John 14:1~ Do not let your hearts be troubled. Exercise faith in God, exercise faith also in me.

- 1· Yet to reassure his disciples, he told them not to let their hearts be troubled. Rather they should exercise faith in God, and also in him, for despite these tumultuous events, none of those present were going to be rejected.

[Question] What did Jesus then tell his disciples that they should continue to trust in, and how could they do this, despite what was about to happen among them?

- 2· I leave you peace. I give you my peace. I do not give it to you the way that the world gives it. Do not let your hearts be troubled, nor let them shrink for fear. (John 14:27)

[Question] What did Jesus then tell his disciples that he was leaving with them, and what did he tell them not to fear?

- 3· And in reply Jesus said to them; Have faith in God. (Mark 11:22)

[Question] What did Jesus tell them to have faith in, despite what was coming upon them that night?

- 4· Who through him are believers in God, the one who raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory, so that your faith and hope, might be in God. (1 Peter 1:21)

[Question] What are all anointed Christians, and who do they look to in faith as their God, just like Christ did?

- 5· But you also hoped in him, after you heard the word of truth, the Good News about your salvation. By means of him also, after you believed, you were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit. (Ephesians 1:13)

[Question] What makes anointed Christians first hope in Christ, and what then seals this relationship with Yehowah God?

- 6· He will not be afraid even of bad news. His heart is steadfast, made reliant upon Yehowah. (Psalms 112:7)

[Question] How did the Psalmist show, how men are made steadfast?

- 7· You will not need to be afraid of any sudden dreadful thing,

nor of the storm upon the wicked ones, because it is coming. (Proverbs 3:25)

[Question] What do the Proverbs assure those following in Yehowah's way, that they will not need to fear?

8· But because I have spoken these things to you, grief has filled your hearts. (John 16:6)

[Question] How did Jesus' disciples come to feel, as he spoke to them about leaving them, and returning to the Father?

9· I know where you are dwelling, that is, where the throne of Satan is, and yet, you keep on holding fast my name, and you did not deny your faith in me, even in the days of Antipas, my witness, the faithful one, who was killed by your side, where Satan is dwelling. (Revelation 2:13)

[Question] What did Jesus reveal in the Revelation account, about where his disciples were dwelling, and yet how had they behaved?
