

John 14:10~ Do you not believe, that I am in union with the Father, and the Father is in union with me? The things I say to you men, I do not speak of my own originality,¹ but the Father who remains in union with me, is doing his works.

1· So he asked them, if they did not believe, that he was in union with the Father, and that the Father was in union with him? Then he assured them, that all the things he spoke were not coming forth of his own originality, but the Father who was in union with him was doing his works through him.

[Question] What did Jesus then ask Phillip and all the others, if they believed?

[Question] What did Jesus then assure them, about all the things he spoke to them?

2· But if I am doing them, even though you do not believe me, believe the works, in order, that you may come to know, and may continue knowing, that the Father is in union with me, and I am in union with the Father. (John 10:38)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples to believe, even if they did not choose to believe his words, for what did he want them to know?

3· In order, that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in union with me, and I am in union with you, that they also may be in union with us, in order, that the world may believe, that you sent me forth. (John 17:21)

[Question] What kind of spiritual unity did Jesus Christ want all his disciples to have, and with whom?

4· Jesus, in turn, answered them and said; What I teach is not mine, but belongs to him that sent me. (John 7:16)

[Question] What did Jesus show about all the things he taught, and where they came forth from?

5· Therefore Jesus said; When once you have lifted up the Son of man, then you will know that I am he, and that I do nothing of my own initiative, but just as the Father taught me, I speak these things. (John 8:28)

[Question] What did Jesus state his disciples would know, when they lifted him up, for where did his teachings come forth from?

- 6· Because I have not spoken out of my **own** impulse, but the **Father** himself who sent me, has given me a commandment, as to what to tell, and what to **speak**. (**John 12:49**)

[Question] Who told Jesus Christ what to speak among the sons of men?

- 7· Who has put faith in the thing heard by us? And as for the arm of Yehowah, to whom has it been revealed? (**Isaiah 53:1**)

[Question] How did Isaiah prophesy about this future witness, and how the power of Yehowah God's arm, would be revealed to these ones?

- 8· But he answered them; My **Father** has kept working until now, and I keep working. (**John 5:17**)

[Question] What did Jesus state, that his father had kept doing, and so what would he also do?

- 9· And yet, if I do judge, my judgment is truthful, because I **am** not alone, but the **Father** who sent me, is with me. (**John 8:16**)

[Question] Why would the judgment of Jesus Christ be truthful, for who was always with him, directing him?

- 10· And he that sent me is with me. He did not abandon me to myself, because I always do the **things** pleasing to him. (**John 8:29**)

[Question] Why did Yehowah God not abandon Jesus Christ to himself, for whose will did he always do?

- 11· What **things** I have seen with my **Father**, I **speak**. You, therefore, do the **things** you have heard from your father. (**John 8:38**)

[Question] What things did Jesus speak in the world, yet what things did the Jews speak from?

- 12· Jesus answered them; I told you, and yet you do not

believe. The **works** that I am doing in the name of my **Father**, these bear witness about me. (**John 10:25**)

[Question] What did Jesus tell men, was proof enough for them to believe in him?

13· Because the sayings that you gave me I have given to them, and they have received them, and have certainly come to know, that I came out as your representative, and they have believed, that you sent me forth. (**John 17:8**)

[Question] What did Jesus' disciples come to realize, after accepting his words and teachings?

14· Men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus the Nazarene, a man publicly shown by God to you, through powerful **works** and portents and signs, that God did through him in your midst, just as you yourselves know. (**Acts of Apostles 2:22**)

[Question] How was Jesus made manifest to mankind, and whose power was behind all he did?
