

John 14:13~ **Also, whatever it is that you ask in my name, I will do this, in order, that the Father may be glorified in connection with the Son.**

1· So he told them, that whatever they asked the Father for in his name to accomplish his will on earth, he would do this for them, in order for the Father to be glorified in connection with his Son.

[Question] What did Jesus then tell his disciples, that they would receive if they asked for it in his name, and who would this glorify?

2· You did not choose me, but I chose you, and I appointed you to go on and keep bearing fruit, and that your fruit should remain, in order, that no matter what you ask the Father in my name, he might give it to you. (John 15:16)

[Question] Do spirit anointed Christians choose Christ, or the other way around?

[Question] What then, is expected of them from then on, and what are these spiritual fruitages?

3· And in that day you will ask me no question at all. Most truly I say to you, if you ask the Father for anything, he will give it to you in my name. (John 16:23)

[Question] What did Jesus state, that the Father would give them upon asking in his name for it?

4· For everyone asking receives, and everyone seeking finds, and to everyone knocking it will be opened. (Matthew 7:8)

[Question] What did Jesus show, that persons asking, and seeking, and knocking, would find?

5· Again I truly say to you, if two of you on earth agree concerning anything of importance that they should request, it will take place for them, due to my Father in heaven. (Matthew 18:19)

[Question] What would Yehowah God grant to any two or more of Christ's disciples, who agreed upon anything?

6· And all the things you ask in prayer, having faith, you will receive. (Matthew 21:22)

[Question] How should anointed Christians view anything they have asked for previously in prayer?

- 7· **This is why I tell you, all the things you pray and ask for, have faith that you have practically received, and you will have them. (Mark 11:24)**

[Question] How should anointed Christians feel, while waiting for the fulfillment of their requests made in prayer to God?

- 8· **Hence when he had gone out, Jesus said; Now the Son of man is glorified, and God is glorified in connection with him. (John 13:31)**

[Question] What did Jesus state to his disciples, as soon as Judas Iscariot left, and why did his leaving glorify both Yehowah God and his Christ?

- 9· **I have glorified you on the earth, having finished the work you have given me to do. (John 17:4)**

[Question] What could Jesus say at the end of that night of testing?

- 10· **Further, if we know he hears us respecting whatever we are asking, we know we are to have the things asked, since we have asked them of him. (1 John 5:15)**

[Question] What confidence do anointed Christians have in their prayers, whether voiced or not?
