

John 14:15~

**If you love me, you will observe my commandments.**

1· Then Jesus told his disciples that they could show that they loved him by observing his commandments, putting into practice his teachings, and following after his fine example of self-sacrificing service to others.

**[Question]** How did Jesus show, what his disciples must do to show that they loved Jesus?

**[Question]** What then, should they keep doing in remembrance of him?

2· I am giving you a new commandment, that you **love** one another, just as I have loved you, that you also, **love** one another. (**John 13:34**)

**[Question]** What new commandment did Jesus give to his disciples, and what was new about it?

3· If you **observe** my **commandments**, you **will** remain in my **love**, just as I have observed the **commandments** of the Father, and remain in his **love**. (**John 15:10**)

**[Question]** What must anointed Christians do to remain in Jesus Christ's love?

4· However, become doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves with false reasoning. (**James 1:22**)

**[Question]** What did James encourage anointed Christians disciples to become, regarding the word of truth?

**[Question]** What would they be doing, if they knew the word, but did not practice it?

5· In answer Peter and the other apostles said; We must obey God as ruler rather than men. (**Acts of Apostles 5:29**)

**[Question]** Who did Peter and John show, that they must obey?

6· And this is what **love** means, that we go on walking according to his **commandments**. This is the commandment, just as you people have heard from the beginning, that you should go on walking in it. (**2 John 1:6**)

**[Question]** What does it mean, to love Yehowah God and his Christ?
