John 14:15~ If you love me, you will observe my commandments.

1. Then Jesus told his disciples that they could show that they loved him by observing his commandments, putting into practice his teachings, and following after his fine example of self-sacrificing service to others.

[Question] How did Jesus show, what his disciples must do to show that they loved Jesus?

[Question] What then, should they keep doing in remembrance of him?

2. I am giving you a new commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you, that you also, love one another. (John 13:34)

[Question] What new commandment did Jesus give to his disciples, and what was new about it?

3. If you observe my commandments, you will remain in my love, just as I have observed the commandments of the Father, and remain in his love. (John 15:10)

[Question] What must anointed Christians do to remain in Jesus Christ's love?

4. However, become doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves with false reasoning. (James 1:22)

[Question] What did James encourage anointed Christians disciples to become, regarding the word of truth?

[Question] What would they be doing, if they knew the word, but did not practice it?

5. In answer Peter and the other apostles said; We must obey God as ruler rather than men. (Acts of Apostles 5:29)

[Question] Who did Peter and John show, that they must obey?

6. And this is what love means, that we go on walking according to his commandments. This is the commandment, just as you people have heard from the beginning, that you should go on walking in it. (2 John 1:6)

[Question] What does it mean, to love Yehowah God and his Christ?
