^{John 14:17~} The spirit¹ of the truth, which the world cannot receive, because it neither beholds it,² nor knows it. You know it, because it remains with you, and is in you.

1. Then Jesus showed, what this helper would be. It was the spirit of the truth, for everything it told them would be truth, and they could depend upon it being a true director of their spiritual lives. Now the world in general would not know the Holy Spirit, for the physical or non-spiritual man thinks that such things are mere foolishness, because they cannot see them of touch them. However Jesus' disciples would know the spirit, for it would touch their lives and remain within them directing their hearts and minds.

[Question] How did Jesus identify this spirit, and what would it serve as, for them in their spiritual lives?

[Question] What would this spirit, unseen to men, but felt by Jesus' disciples, serve as within them?

2. For the ones speaking are not just you, but it is the spirit of your Father that speaks by you. (Matthew 10:20)

[Question] Who did Jesus show would be the ones speaking, when they were brought before worldly authorities for his sake?

3. However, when that one arrives, the spirit of the truth, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak of his own impulse, but what things he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things coming. (John 16:13)

[Question] What did Jesus tell them, that this spirit of the truth would guide them into, both past and present?

4 Now we received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is from God, that we might know the things that have been kindly given us by God. (1 Corinthians 2:12)

[Question] What kind of spirit do anointed Christians receive, and what does it teach them?

5. And as for you, the anointing that you received from him remains in you, and you do not need anyone to be teaching you, but, as the anointing from him is teaching you about all things, and is true and is no lie, and just as it has taught you, remain in union with him. (1 John 2:27)

[Question] What remains within anointed Christians, and what does it continually do for them?

[Question] What therefore do anointed Christians have to depend upon and rely upon always?

6 But a physical man does not receive the things of the spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot get to know them, because they are examined spiritually. (1 Corinthians 2:14)

[Question] How does the physical man feel about the spirit, and why?

[Question] What things, does he then find hard to understand?

 Now because you are sons, God has sent forth the spirit of his Son into our hearts and it cries out; Abba, Father! (Galatians 4:6)

[Question] How does the Holy Spirit make anointed Christians feel, when it comes within them?

8. And upon him the spirit of Yehowah must settle down, the spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the spirit of counsel and of mightiness, the spirit of knowledge, and of the fear of Yehowah. (Isaiah 11:2)

[Question] What did Isaiah prophesy would come upon Yehowah God's Messiah, also what kind of a spirit would it be?

9. The wind blows where it wants to, and you hear the sound of it, but you do not know where it comes from, and where it is going. So is everyone, that has been born from the spirit. (John 3:8)

[Question] How is the Holy Spirit like the wind, and what do men not know about where it might lead them?

10. Nevertheless, the hour is coming, and it is now, when the true worshipers will worship the Father with spirit and truth, for, indeed, the Father is looking for suchlike ones to worship him. (John 4:23)

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[Question] What hour did Jesus show to a Samaritan woman, that was coming, and how then would the true worshipers worship the Father?

11. The spirit itself bears witness with our spirit, that we are God's children. (Romans 8:16)

[Question] What bears witness to God's sons, that they are true anointed Christians?

13. Yet he who searches the hearts, knows what the meaning of the spirit is, because it is pleading in accord with God for holy ones. (Romans 8:27)

[Question] How can Yehowah God search out our hearts and thoughts through the Holy Spirit, even though we do not express in words, what we are feeling,?

13[•] For who among men knows the things of a man except the spirit of man that is in him? So, too, no one has come to know the things of God, except the spirit of God. (1 Corinthians 2:11)

[Question] What is most intimately knowledgeable about the things of a man?

[Question] What also is most intimately knowledgeable about God?

14. For you are shown to be a letter of Christ written by us as ministers, inscribed not with ink but with spirit of a living God, not on stone tablets, but on fleshly tablets, on hearts. (2 Corinthians 3:3)

[Question] What were the anointed Christians living in Corinth Greece like, toward Paul?

[Question] Where was this letter of recommendation written, and what was the writing medium, and the tablet written upon?

[Question] How did Paul also show a correspondency to the writing of the stone tablets of the Law Covenant, for where are God's Laws written within Christians?

 15. We originate with God. He that gains the knowledge of God listens to us. He that does not originate with God does not listen to us. This is how we take note of the inspired expression of truth and the inspired expression of error. (1 John 4:6)

[Question] Who tends to listen to anointed Christians' preaching?
