John 14:18~ I shall not leave you bereaved. I am coming to you.

1. Now to comfort them, he promised that he would not leave them bereaved, for he knew that within the next day he was going to die. Yet he also knew, that he was within three days going to be resurrected, and then they would rejoice. So he did not want them to be overcome by their grief.
