

John 14:23~ In answer Jesus said to him; **If anyone loves me, he will observe my word, and my Father will love him, and we shall come to him, and make our abode with him.**

- 1· So Jesus answered, by stating, that if anyone loves Jesus, that then God and Christ would come to them in spirit, and make their abode with them.

[Question] What did Jesus then state, about anyone loving him, and what they would experience from Yehowah God and his Christ?

- 2· If you **observe** my commandments, you **will** remain in my **love**, just as I have observed the commandments of the **Father**, and remain in his **love**. (**John 15:10**)

[Question] How can anointed Christians remain in Christ's love, for how did Christ remain in God's love?

- 3· As for you, let that which you have heard from the beginning remain in you. If that which you have heard from the beginning remains in you, you **will** also abide in union with the Son, and in union with the **Father**. (**1 John 2:24**)

[Question] What should anointed Christians let remain within them always, and if they do, then what will they experience?

- 4· Look! I am standing at the door and knocking. If **anyone** hears my voice and opens the door, I **will come** into his house, and take the evening meal with him, and he with me. (**Revelation 3:20**)

[Question] Where did Jesus state, that he would be standing and knocking, and what would he do for anyone inviting him into his house?

- 5· And extending his hand toward his disciples, he **said**; Look! My mother and my brothers! (**Matthew 12:49**)

[Question] Who did Jesus feel were truly his mother and brothers?

- 6· He that feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood, remains in union with me, and I in union with him. (**John 6:56**)

[Question] What must true anointed Christians do, to remain in union with Jesus Christ?

- 7· **You are my friends, if you do what I am commanding you. (John 15:14)**

[Question] Who did Jesus state, would be considered to be his friends?

- 8· **To have the Christ dwell through your faith in your hearts, with love, that you may be rooted and established on the foundation. (Ephesians 3:17)**

[Question] What did Paul want for anointed to have dwell within their hearts?

- 9· **But whoever does observe his word, truthfully, in this person, the love of God has been made perfect. By this, we have the knowledge, that we are in union with him. (1 John 2:5)**

[Question] In what person is the love of God made perfect?

- 10· **Moreover, he who observes his commandments remains in union with him, and he, in union with such one, and by this we gain the knowledge, that he is remaining in union with us, owing to the spirit which he gave us. (1 John 3:24)**

[Question] Who does Christ remain in union with, and how do anointed Christians know, that they are remaining in union with Yehowah God and his Christ?
