

John 14:24~ He that does not love me, does not observe my words. The word that you are hearing, is not mine, but belongs to the Father, who sent me.

1· Jesus then showed, that persons who did not observe his words, really did not love him. Also he was not the one saying this, but the Father who send him, was who said this.

[Question] What did Jesus then show, about people who did not practice his teachings, and where did this saying come forth from?

2· Therefore, in answer, Jesus went on to say to them, most truly I say to you, the Son cannot do a single thing of his own initiative, but only what he beholds the Father doing. For whatever things that One does, these things the Son also does in like manner. (John 5:19)

[Question] Does the Son do anything of his own initiative, and who does he always imitate?

3· Jesus, in turn, answered them and said; What I teach is not mine, but belongs to him that sent me. (John 7:16)

[Question] Where did Jesus reveal, that his teachings came forth from, and whose teaching were they?

4· Because I have not spoken out of my own impulse, but the Father himself who sent me, has given me a commandment as to what to tell, and what to speak. (John 12:49)

[Question] Who told Jesus, what to speak and to teach?
