John 14:26~ But the helper, ¹ the Holy Spirit, which the Father will send in my name, that one ² will teach you all things, and bring back to your minds, all the things I told you.

1. Jesus then told them, that in the future, the Holy Spirit would be with them in his absence, for the Father would send it to be with them in his name. That one will teach you all things, that they needed to know, and would recall to their minds, all the things he had previously taught them.

[Question] What did Jesus show, would then be with them in his absence?

[Question] What then, would the Holy Spirit do for them, and what things of the past would it accurately recall for them?

2. And, look! I am sending forth upon you that which is promised by my Father. You, though, abide in the city until you become clothed with power from on high. (Luke 24:49)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples that he would send upon them, and where were they to stay until that happened?

3. When the helper arrives, that I will send you from the Father, the spirit of the truth, which proceeds from the Father, that one will bear witness about me. (John 15:26)

[Question] Who did Jesus tell them he was sending to be with them, and what did he call this spirit?

4. However, when that one arrives, the spirit of the truth, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak of his own impulse, but what things he hears, he will speak, and he will declare to you, the things coming. (John 16:13)

[Question] What would the spirit of the truth, then guide his disciples into?

5. And as for you, the anointing that you received from him remains in you, and you do not need anyone to be teaching you, but, as the anointing from him is teaching you about all things, and is true and is no lie, and just as it has taught you, remain in union with him. (1 John 2:27)

[Question] What teaches true anointed Christians, and do they need other teachers to teach them?

[Question] What can they totally depend upon, about this spirit?

6 Teach me to do your will, for you are my God. Your spirit is good. May it lead me in the land of uprightness. (Psalms 143:10)

[Question] What did the Psalmist ask of his God to do for him, for where did he trust that Yehowah God's spirit would lead him?

7. For the ones speaking are not just you, but it is the spirit of your Father that speaks by you. (Matthew 10:20)

[Question] Who would be actually speaking, when anointed Christians were called before worldly rulers, to bear witness?

8' When, though, he was raised up from the dead, his disciples called to mind, that he used to say this, and they believed the Scripture, and the saying that Jesus said. (John 2:22)

[Question] What did Jesus' disciples in fact recall to their minds after his resurrection?

9. These things his disciples took no note of at first, but when Jesus became glorified, then they called to mind, that these things were written respecting him, and that they did these things to him. (John 12:16)

[Question] What did Jesus disciples call to mind, only after the fact, and what force within them, made them realize these things accurately?

10" Nevertheless, I am telling you the truth, it is for your benefit I am going away. For if I do not go away, the helper will by no means come to you, but if I do go my way, I will send him to you. (John 16:7)

[Question] For whose benefit was Jesus going away from his disciples?

[Question] What would he send to them, to be with them, only after his ascension to heaven?

11. And they all became filled with Holy Spirit, and started to speak with different tongues, just as the spirit was

granting them to make utterance. (Acts of Apostles 2:4)

[Question] What did the Holy Spirit empower his disciples to do, on the day of Pentecost?

12. Therefore because he was exalted to the right hand of God, and received the promised Holy Spirit from the Father, he has poured out, this which you see and hear. (Acts of Apostles 2:33)

[Question] How did Peter then bear witness, to what happened there at Pentecost, to a crowd of Jews gathered together there?

13. For it is to us, God has revealed them through his spirit, for the spirit searches into all things, even the deep things of God. (1 Corinthians 2:10)

[Question] How does Yehowah God reveal spiritual matters to his spirit anointed children, for where does the spirit of God go, and what does it search out?

14. Now because you are sons, God has sent forth the spirit of his Son into our hearts, and it cries out; Abba, Father! (Galatians 4:6)

[Question] What spirit has Yehowah God placed within all his spiritual sons, and how does it make us feel?

15. All Scripture is inspired of God and beneficial for teaching, for reproving, for setting things straight, for disciplining in righteousness. (2 Timothy 3:16)

[Question] What is all scripture useful for, and who inspired the writing of it?
