

**John 14:27~** I leave you peace. I give you my peace. I do not give it to you the way that the world gives it. Do not let your hearts be troubled, nor let them shrink, or fear.

**1·** So he said to them, that he offered them his peace. He did not give it to them the way that the world offered peace to others. He did not want their hearts to be troubled, neither did he want them to shrink back from fear, at the events that were about to come upon them, and quit in the work he had given them.

**[Question]** What did Jesus then tell his disciples, that he left with them?

**[Question]** How did Jesus want his disciples to feel, even though the events upcoming would be difficult to bear?

**2·** I have said these things to you, that by means of me, you may have **peace**. In the **world** you are having tribulation, but take courage! I have conquered the world. (**John 16:33**)

**[Question]** Why had Jesus told his disciples these things?

**[Question]** What were his disciples experiencing in the world, but what would give them a fine hope for the future?

**3·** For he is our **peace**, he who made the two parties one and destroyed the wall in between, that fenced them off. (**Ephesians 2:14**)

**[Question]** What is Jesus Christ for Jews and Gentiles, for what did he destroy that fenced them off from one another?

**4·** And the **peace** of God, that excels all thought, will guard your **hearts** and your mental powers by means of Christ Jesus. (**Philippians 4:7**)

**[Question]** What did Paul show, would guard the hearts and minds of true anointed Christians?

**[Question]** What is this peace from Yehowah God better than?

**5·** Also, **let** the **peace** of the Christ control in your **hearts**, for you were, in fact, called to it in one body. And show yourselves thankful. (**Colossians 3:15**)

**[Question]** What should anointed Christians let control in their hearts, for how must they all fit together as one body?

- 6· Now may the Lord of **peace** himself **give you peace** constantly in every **way**. The Lord be with all of you. (**2 Thessalonians 3:16**)

**[Question]** What did Paul repeatedly ask for his anointed Christian brothers to have among them, and who gives this peace?

- 7· May Yehowah lift up his face toward you, and assign **peace** to you. (**Numbers 6:26**)

**[Question]** What did Moses say to the Israelites along similar lines as what Paul said?

- 8· For there has been a child born to us, there has been a son given to us. The princely rule will come to be upon his shoulder. His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. (**Isaiah 9:6**)

**[Question]** Who has been given to anointed Christians, and what rulership will rest upon his shoulders?

**[Question]** What future roles would this one come to play toward God's people?

- 9· The inclination that is well supported you will safeguard in continuous **peace**, because it is in you, that one is made to trust. (**Isaiah 26:3**)

**[Question]** What inclination will Yehowah God safeguard through peace, toward those trusting in him?

- 10· O Yehowah, you will adjudge **peace** to us, because even all our works, you have performed for us. (**Isaiah 26:12**)

**[Question]** What will Yehowah God adjudge to men who do his will, as set forth for them?

- 11· Greater will the glory of this later house become, than that of the former, Yehowah of armies has said. And in this place I shall **give** peace, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies. (**Haggai 2:9**)

**[Question]** What did Yehowah God promise to his people after their return to the Promised Land, and rebuilding his temple?

- 12· **But he said to the woman; Your faith has saved you. Go your way in peace. (Luke 7:50)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus state to a woman whom he healed, and what did her faith bring to her from Yehowah God?

- 13· **Do not let your hearts be troubled. Exercise faith in God, exercise faith also in me. (John 14:1)**

**[Question]** Whom did Jesus tell his disciples to exercise faith in, and how did he want them to feel?

- 14· **For the kingdom of God does not mean eating and drinking, but means righteousness, and peace, and joy with Holy Spirit. (Romans 14:17)**

**[Question]** What does the Kingdom of God mean, and not mean?

- 15· **Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, for he has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in union with Christ. (Ephesians 1:3)**

**[Question]** What blessings has Yehowah God given to his spirit anointed Christian sons in the heavenly places?
