

**John 14:29~** **So now I have told you before it occurs, in order, that, when it does occur, you may believe.**

**1· So Jesus had now told them before it happened, that he was going away, so that when it did occur, that they might believe, that the Father had sent him.**

**[Question]** Why then did Jesus tell his disciples all these things in advance?

**2· From this moment on I am telling you before it occurs, in order, that when it does occur, you may believe, that I am he. (John 13:19)**

**[Question]** Why did Jesus tell his disciples in advance, things that were going to happen shortly?

**3· Nevertheless, I have spoken these things to you that, when the hour for them arrives, you may remember I told them to you. These things, however, I did not tell you at first, because I was with you. (John 16:4)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus want his disciples to remember when the time came that they were fulfilled?
