1. So Jesus had now told them before it happened, that he was going away, so that when it did occur, that they might believe, that the Father had sent him.

[Question] Why then did Jesus tell his disciples all these things in advance?

2. From this moment on I am telling you before it occurs, in order, that when it does occur, you may believe, that I am he. (John 13:19)

[Question] Why did Jesus tell his disciples in advance, things that were going to happen shortly?

3. Nevertheless, I have spoken these things to you that, when the hour for them arrives, you may remember I told them to you. These things, however, I did not tell you at first, because I was with you. (John 16:4)

[Question] What did Jesus want his disciples to remember when the time came that they were fulfilled?
