Also, if I go my way and prepare a place for you, I am coming again, and will receive you home to myself, that where I anymore, you also may be.

1. Also he told them, that if he went away to prepare a place for them, that he would come again and take them home to himself, that where he was, that they also might come to be.

[Question] What did Jesus then reveal was going to result from his going away for a time, and where would his disciples later be brought?

2. And they said; Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into the sky? This Jesus who was received up from you into the sky, will come thus in the same manner, as you have beheld him going into the sky. (Acts of Apostles 1:11)

[Question] How did the angels reveal the manner in which Christ would return?

[Question] Would the whole world then see it, or would it be revealed to some of his disciples privately?

3. Father, as to what you have given me, I wish, that where I am, they also may be with me, in order to behold my glory that you have given me, because you loved me before the founding of the world. (John 17:24)

[Question] What did Jesus want for all of his spirit anointed Christian disciples, and what did he want them to see?

4. If, then, we are children, we are also heirs. Heirs indeed of God, but joint heirs with Christ, provided we suffer together that we may also be glorified together. (Romans 8:17)

[Question] What does being children of God also make all true spirit anointed Christians, and who are they joint heirs with, and what belongs to Jesus Christ?

5. But each one in his own rank. Christ the firstfruits, afterward those who belong to the Christ, during his presence. (1 Corinthians 15:23)

[Question] How will the resurrection proceed, and who will come forth first?

[Question] When then, will the resurrection of Christ's disciples take place?

6. I am under pressure from these two things, but what I do desire is the releasing, and the being with Christ, for this, to be sure, is far better. (Philippians 1:23)

[Question] What two outcomes stood before Paul during his life, yet which would he prefer?

7. Because the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a commanding call, with an archangel's voice, and with God's trumpet, and those who are dead in union with Christ, will rise first. (1 Thessalonians 4:16)

[Question] How does the Bible show, that Jesus will descend from heaven, and what voice will he call out with, effecting what?

8. From this time on there is reserved for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will give me as a reward in that day, yet not only to me, but also to all those who have loved his manifestation. (2 Timothy 4:8)

[Question] What did Paul know was reserved for him, after years of faithful service, and who else was this reserved for?

9. Therefore, brothers, since we have boldness for the way of entry into the holy place by the blood of Jesus. (Hebrews 10:19)

[Question] What does the blood of Jesus give true anointed Christians boldness, to seek out continually?

10" Afterward, we the living who are surviving will, together with them, be caught away in clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and thus, we shall always be with the Lord. (1 Thessalonians 4:17)

[Question] When will those who are still on earth, be brought to the Lord, and who will they then always reside with?

11. My dear one has answered and said to me; Rise up, you girl companion of mine, my beautiful one, and come away. (Song of Solomon 2:10)

**[Question]** How is this action poetically described in the Song of Solomon?

12. If anyone would minister to me, let him follow me, and where I anymore, there my minister will be also. If anyone would minister to me, the Father will honor him. (John 12:26)

[Question] What counsel did Jesus give to anyone wanting to minister to him?

[Question] How would the Father then treat anyone ministering to Christ?

13. Simon Peter said to him; Lord, where are you going?

Jesus answered; Where I am going you cannot follow me now, but you will follow afterwards. (John 13:36)

[Question] What did Peter ask Jesus, and how was he answered?

14. It is sown a physical body, it is raised up a spiritual body. If there is a physical body, there is also a spiritual one. (1 Corinthians 15:44)

[Question] How is our human body first sown, and how is it raised up?

[Question] Which body comes forth first, and which last?

We are therefore always of good courage, and know, that while we have our home in the body, we are absent from the Lord. (2 Corinthians 5:6)

[Question] What did Paul recognize, about the time he spent in his human body?

16. This hope we have as an anchor for the soul, both sure and firm, and it enters in within the curtain. (Hebrews 6:19)

[Question] What does this hope serve as for anointed Christians, who must suffer during their time, within this, Satan the Devil's world?

[Question] Where does this hope take them, through intimacy through the Holy Spirit?

17. Beloved ones, now we are children of God, but as yet it has not been made manifest what we shall be. We do know that whenever he is made manifest we shall be like him, because we shall see him just as he is. (1 John 3:2)
