

**John 14:6~** Jesus said to him; **I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father, except through me.**

1· So Jesus clarified to Thomas and the others present what he meant. He said that he was the way, and the truth, and the life, and they surely did know him. Also he told them where he was going, when he said that no one comes to the Father except through him alone. So he was going to his heavenly Father, Yehowah God, and they must follow in his course to get there also, for he was the only way to the Father.

**[Question]** What did Jesus then clarify, as to the way to get there?

**[Question]** How did he show where he was going, more clearly?

**[Question]** What then, were his disciples going, and how must they act to get there?

2· I **am** the door. Whoever enters **through** me will be saved, and he will go in and out, and find pasturage. (**John 10:9**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus show that he was, and what would anyone entering through him do, and find?

3· Through whom, also we have gained our approach by faith, into this undeserved kindness, in which we now stand. Let us exult, based on hope of the glory of God. (**Romans 5:2**)

**[Question]** How do anointed Christians gain an approach to Yehowah God?

**[Question]** What reasons for rejoicing do they have?

4· Because **through** him we, both peoples, have the approach to the **Father** by one spirit. (**Ephesians 2:18**)

**[Question]** How do both Jews and Gentiles approach Yehowah God under the Christian system of things?

5· Which he inaugurated for us as a new and living **way through** the curtain, that is, his flesh. (**Hebrews 10:20**)

**[Question]** What inaugurated for anointed Christians, a new and living way through the curtain, into the very presence of Yehowah God?

6· Because the Law was given **through** Moses, the undeserved kindness and the **truth** came to be **through** Jesus Christ.

**(John 1:17)**

**[Question]** What came through Moses, and what comes through Jesus Christ?

- 7· For I say, that Christ actually became a minister of those who are circumcised, in behalf of God's truthfulness, so as to verify the promises he made to their forefathers.

**(Romans 15:8)**

**[Question]** Why did Jesus Christ come forth to the Jews?

- 8· Provided, indeed, that you heard him and were taught by means of him, just as **truth** is in Jesus. **(Ephesians 4:21)**

**[Question]** What is in Jesus?

- 9· For those things are a shadow of the things to come, but the reality belongs to the Christ. **(Colossians 2:17)**

**[Question]** What was the Law Covenant, and what did it point to?

- 10· By means of him was **life**, and the **life** was the light of men. **(John 1:4)**

**[Question]** What come to mankind through Jesus Christ, and what does that hope, do for the vision of men?

- 11· It is the spirit that is life-giving. The flesh is of no use at all. The sayings that I have spoken to you are spirit, and are **life**. **(John 6:63)**

**[Question]** What within us, is life giving, and what is not?

**[Question]** What are the sayings of Jesus Christ?

- 12· This means everlasting **life**, their taking in knowledge of you, the only true God, and of the one whom you sent forth, Jesus Christ. **(John 17:3)**

**[Question]** What means everlasting life?

- 13· For the wages sin pays, is death, but the gift God gives, is everlasting **life**, by Christ Jesus our Lord. **(Romans 6:23)**

**[Question]** What wages does sin pay, to those working in its behalf?

**[Question]** What gift does Yehowah God give, and through whom?

- 14· Do not be afraid of the things you are about to suffer. Look! The Devil will keep on throwing some of you into prison, that you may be fully put to the test, and that you may have tribulation ten days. Prove yourself faithful even to death, and I will give you the crown of **life**. (**Revelation 2:10**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus show, that his disciples would continue to suffer in his behalf, within this Satan the Devil's system of things?

- 15· Furthermore, there is no salvation in anyone else, for there is not another name under heaven, that has been given among men, by which we must get saved. (**Acts of Apostles 4:12**)

**[Question]** Is there true salvation in any other name, than in Jesus Christ's name?

- 16· And the entrance of the innermost room he made with doors of oil-tree wood, side pillars, doorposts, and a fifth. (**1 Kings 6:31**)

**[Question]** What separated the Holy and Most Holy of the temple from the outside, and what were they made of?

- 17· Kiss the son, that He may not become incensed, and you may not perish from the **way**, for his anger flares up easily. Happy are all those taking refuge in him. (**Psalms 2:12**)

**[Question]** What counsel does the Psalmist give to men, who are alive when the Christ begins his rule of the earth, and why?

- 18· For the one finding me, will certainly find **life**, and gets goodwill from Yehowah. (**Proverbs 8:35**)

**[Question]** What will the one finding wisdom from Yehowah God, also find?

- 19· And he must become as a sacred place, but as a stone to strike against, and as a rock over which to stumble, to both the houses of Israel, as a trap, and as a snare, to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. (**Isaiah 8:14**)

**[Question]** What was it prophesied, that the Messiah would become to both house of Israel, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem?

- 20· And as a grain offering you should provide with it, morning

by morning, the sixth of an ephah, and, as regards oil, the third of a hin, for sprinkling the fine flour. The grain offering to Yehowah is an indefinitely lasting statute, constantly. **(Ezekiel 46:14)**

**[Question]** What was the constant offering made at the temple of Yehowah God day by day, and when was it offered daily?

- 21· Therefore Jesus **said** again; **Most truly I say to you, I am the door of the sheep.** **(John 10:7)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus say, that he represented for his sheeplike followers?

- 22· Jesus **said** to her; **I am the resurrection and the life.** He that exercises faith in me, even though he dies, will come to **life.** **(John 11:25)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus state to Martha when resurrecting Lazarus?

- 23· Therefore Pilate **said** to him; **Well, then, are you a king?** Jesus answered; **You yourself are saying that I am a king.** For this, I have been born, and for this, I have come into the world, **that I should bear witness to the truth.** Everyone that is on the side of the **truth** listens to my voice. **(John 18:37)**

**[Question]** How did Jesus answer Pilates question, as to whether he was a king?

**[Question]** Why did Jesus come into the world, and who listens to his voice within this world?

- 24· **By means of whom we have this freeness of speech and an approach with confidence through our faith in him.** **(Ephesians 3:12)**

**[Question]** What do anointed Christians gain toward Yehowah God through their faith?

- 25· **For the Law made nothing perfect, but the bringing in besides of a better hope, did, through which, we are drawing near to God.** **(Hebrews 7:19)**

**[Question]** Did the Law Covenant make anything perfect, yet what does?

- 26· Thus the Holy Spirit makes it plain, that the **way** into the holy place, had not yet been made manifest, while the first tent was standing. (**Hebrews 9:8**)

**[Question]** What is plain, that did not exist toward Yehowah God while the first tent, or temple arrangement was still standing?

- 27· Therefore, brothers, since we have boldness for the **way** of entry into the holy place, by the blood of Jesus. (**Hebrews 10:19**)

**[Question]** What gives anointed Christians boldness to enter the holy place?

- 28· As we look intently at the Chief Agent and Perfecter of our faith, Jesus. For the joy that was set before him, he endured a torture stake, despising shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. (**Hebrews 12:2**)

**[Question]** Who is the chief agent and Perfecter of every anointed Christian's faith?

**[Question]** What did Jesus Christ willingly suffer through, and why?

- 29· Who **through** him are believers in God, the one who raised him up from the dead and gave him glory, so that your faith and hope might be in God. (**1 Peter 1:21**)

**[Question]** Who do anointed Christians put faith in, to raise them up from the dead, like he did for Christ?

- 30· Everyone that pushes ahead, and does not remain in the teaching of the Christ, does not have God. He that does remain in this teaching, is the one, that has both the **Father**, and the Son. (**2 John 1:9**)

**[Question]** What do those who push ahead, following after other teachings, lose?

**[Question]** What do those who remain in these teachings, continue to have?

- 31· And the third angel blew his trumpet. And a great star burning as a lamp fell from heaven, and it fell upon a third of the rivers and upon the fountains of waters. (**Revelation 8:10**)

**[Question]** Upon what sources of drinkable water does the star called wormwood fall?

**32· And no falsehood was found in their mouths, they are without blemish. (Revelation 14:5)**

**[Question]** What is not found within the mouths of spirit anointed Christians?
