John 14:7~ If you men had known me, you would have known my Father also, from this moment on, you know him, and have seen him.

1. So Jesus told them, that to the extent that they have known him, they have also come to know the Father. Then he showed, that from this moment on they did know God, and had seen him, because they had come to know his Son, who was the exact image of him, while in the flesh.

[Question] What did Jesus then tell them, about what they already knew about him, and the Father, Yehowah God?

[Question] What was Jesus, so that he could say this to them?

2. All things have been delivered to me by my Father, and no one fully knows the Son, but the Father, neither does anyone fully know the Father, but the Son, and anyone, to whom the Son is willing to reveal him. (Matthew 11:27)

[Question] What things have been delivered to Jesus Christ by Yehowah God?

[Question] Who knows his son the best?

3. No man has seen God at any time, the only-begotten god who is in the bosom position with the Father is the one that has explained him. (John 1:18)

[Question] Has any man seen God while a man?

[Question] Who has explained Yehowah God, because he knew Yehowah God best of all, because he lived with Yehowah God in heaven?

4. Therefore they went on to say to him; Where is your Father? Jesus answered; You know neither me nor my Father. If you did know me, you would know my Father also. (John 8:19)

[Question] What did Jews mockingly say to Jesus, and how did he respond?

5. At no time has anyone beheld God. If we continue loving one another, God remains in us, and his love is made perfect in us. (1 John 4:12)

[Question] Who any man ever beheld God?
