John 14:9~ Jesus said to him; Have I been with you men so long a time, and yet, Philip, you have not come to know me? He that has seen me has seen the Father also. How is it you say; Show us the Father?

1. So Jesus became somewhat impatient, that Phillip was not getting the point, so he asked Phillip, if he had been with Jesus for such a long time, now some three years, and yet he had not come to know him? Then he said, that he that has seen me, has seen the Father also, for he was just like his Father. So he asked Phillip again; How is it that you say, show us the father.
