

John 15:1~

I am the true vine, and my Father is the cultivator.

- 1· Then Jesus told his disciples, that he was the true vine, and his heavenly Father was the cultivator of this vine.

[Question] What did Jesus then show through illustration, that he was, and what was his heavenly Father toward this vine?

- 2· In that day what Yehowah makes sprout will come to be for decoration and for glory, and the fruitage of the land will be something to be proud of and something beautiful for those of Israel who have escaped. (**Isaiah 4:2**)

[Question] What promise of future fruitfulness did Isaiah make prophetically for the land and people of Israel?

- 3· You proceeded to make a **vine** depart from Egypt. You kept driving out the nations, that you might plant it. (**Psalms 80:8**)

[Question] How did the Psalmist describe illustratively what the wandering of the nation of Israel in the wilderness was like, and what Israel itself was like?

- 4· And as for me, I had planted you as a choice red **vine**, all of it a **true** seed. So how have you been changed toward me into the degenerate shoots of a foreign vine? (**Jeremiah 2:21**)

[Question] What did Yehowah God state, that Israel was like to him, through generations?

[Question] What though, did he plant, and what did this vine later degenerate into?

- 5· For we are God's fellow workers. You people are God's field under cultivation, God's building. (**1 Corinthians 3:9**)

[Question] How did the apostle Paul describe, what spirit anointed Christians are like to God?

- 6· And another angel emerged from the temple sanctuary, crying with a loud voice to the one seated on the cloud; Put your sickle in, and reap, because the hour has come to reap, for the harvest of the earth is thoroughly ripe. (**Revelation 14:15**)

[Question] How does the Revelation account describe the harvesting of the true vine, and the vine of the earth, on judgment day?
