

John 15:12~ This is my commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you.

- 1· **So Jesus again told them his new commandment, that they love one another, just as he had loved them. He gave up his life for them, and because of his great love for them he did this.**

[Question] What is Jesus' new commandment, and what is new about it?

[Question] How did Jesus himself manifest this great love for mankind?

- 2· **The second is this, you must love your neighbor as yourself. There is no other commandment greater than these. (Mark 12:31)**

[Question] What did Jesus state, was the second most important commandment in the Law Covenant, and what was the first?

- 3· **I am giving you a new commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you, that you also love one another. (John 13:34)**

[Question] How did Jesus show, that they must exercise the new commandment he gave to them?

- 4· **However, with reference to brotherly love, you do not need us to be writing you, for you yourselves are taught by God, to love one another. (1 Thessalonians 4:9)**

[Question] Who teaches true anointed Christians to love one another, and how?

- 5· **Above all things, have intense love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins. (1 Peter 4:8)**

[Question] Why should true anointed Christians have intense love for one another?

- 6· **Go on carrying the burdens of one another, and thus fulfill the Law of the Christ. (Galatians 6:2)**

[Question] What should anointed Christians carry for one another, and what Law will they fulfill in doing this?

- 7· **Beloved ones, if this is how God loved us, then we are**

ourselves under obligation, to **love** one another. (**1 John 4:11**)

[Question] What motivates true anointed Christians to love one another?

8· **And this commandment we **have** from him, that the one who **loves** God, should be loving his brother also. (**1 John 4:21**)**

[Question] What must the one claiming to love Yehowah God, also be loving?

9· **So now, I request you, lady, as a person writing you, not a new commandment, but one which we had from the beginning, that we **love** one another. (**2 John 1:5**)**

[Question] What new commandment did John reiterate in his writings many times?
