You did not choose me, but I chose you, and I appointed you to go on and keep bearing fruit, and that your fruit should remain, in order, that no matter what you ask the Father for in my name, he might give it to you.

1. Jesus then told his disciples, that they had not chosen him, but that he had chosen each of them. The reason he had done this choosing of them, was for them to go on bearing fruit, fruit that would remain forever. In respect to this, anything that they might ask the father for to remain fruitful in his service, would be granted to them.

[Question] Who chose all of Christ's disciples, and what did he expect of each one of them?

[Question] What then, could they expect from Yehowah God, if they remained fruitful?

2. Go therefore, and make disciples of people of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. (Matthew 28:19)

[Question] What command did Jesus give to all his faithful disciples, upon ascending to heaven?

3. But I do not want you to fail to know, brothers, that I many times purposed to come to you, but I have been hindered until now, in order, that I might acquire some fruitage also among you, even as among the rest of the nations. (Romans 1:13)

[Question] Why did Paul show, that he had not yet visited Rome and the congregation there?

4. Now, if it be to live on in the flesh, this is a fruitage of my work, and yet which thing to select, I do not make known. (Philippians 1:22)

[Question] What would living on in the flesh produce for Paul?

5. Also, whatever it is that you ask in my name, I will do this, in order, that the Father may be glorified in connection with the Son. (John 14:13)

[Question] What would Yehowah God grant to all those doing his will, if they asked him for it?

6. Still others fell upon the fine soil, and they began to yield fruit, this one a hundredfold, that one sixty, the other thirty. (Matthew 13:8)

[Question] What did all of the seed falling upon the fine soil produce?

7. And he ascended a mountain, and summoned those he wanted, and they went off to him. (Mark 3:13)

[Question] Who did Jesus choose to be his apostles, and what did he send them out to do?

8. Jesus answered them; I chose you twelve, did I not? Yet one of you is a slanderer. (John 6:70)

[Question] Even though Jesus choose all twelve apostles, what did one of them become, of his own choosing, later on?

9. I am not talking about all of you. I know the ones I have chosen. But it is, in order, that the Scripture might be fulfilled: He that used to feed on my bread, has lifted up his heel against me. (John 13:18)

[Question] What scripture had to be fulfilled, and was fulfilled in Judas Iscariot?

10" I am the vine, you are the branches. He that remains in union with me, and I in union with him, this one bears much fruit, because apart from me, you can do nothing at all. (John 15:5)

[Question] What was Jesus relative to his disciples, and what were they?

[Question] What would any branch remaining in union with the root of the vine produce?

[Question] Can false Christians produce anything, why not?

11. And in that day you will ask me no question at all. Most truly I say to you, if you ask the Father for anything, he will give it to you in my name. (John 16:23)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples that Yehowah God would give to them to complete his work among them?

12. Until the day that he was taken up, after he had given commandment through Holy Spirit, to the apostles, whom

he chose. (Acts of Apostles 1:2)

[Question] What commandment did Jesus give to his disciples before his ascension (Matthew 28:19-20)?

13. Which has presented itself to you, even as it is bearing fruit and increasing in all the world, just as it is doing also among you, from the day you heard, and accurately knew the undeserved kindness of God, in truth. (Colossians 1:6)

[Question] What did Paul bear witness to Christians that was bearing fruit and increasing, throughout the known world of his day?
