

John 15:21~ But they will do all these things against you, on account of my name, because they do not know him that sent me.

- 1· Then Jesus showed, that the world would do all these things against them, because, or on account of, his name, because they do not know Yehowah God, who sent Jesus forth.

[Question] Who did these persecutors not know, causing them to persecute others?

- 2· But they will do these things because they have not come to know, either the Father, or me. (John 16:3)

[Question] Why did Jesus show, that people would do these things?

- 3· And you will be objects of hatred by all people on account of my name, but he that has endured to the end, is the one that will be saved. (Matthew 10:22)

[Question] What did Jesus show, that his disciples would become on account of his name, but who would eventually be saved?

- 4· Then people will deliver you up to tribulation, and will kill you, and you will be objects of hatred by all the nations, on account of my name. (Matthew 24:9)

[Question] What did Jesus foretell for his disciples, and how would they come to be viewed by the nations of the earth?

- 5· Righteous Father, the world has, indeed, not come to know you, but I have come to know you, and these have come to know, that you sent me forth. (John 17:25)

[Question] What did Jesus bear witness, that the world had not come to know, that he knew well, and what had his disciples also learned?
