John 15:25~ But it is that the word written in their Law may be fulfilled: They hated me without cause.

1. Jesus then showed, that their behavior was prophesied in the holy scriptures within the Law Covenant where it said: The hated me without cause.

[Question] How did Jesus then show, how this behavior fulfilled the Law Covenant?

2. O may those who for no reason are my enemies, not rejoice over me, as for those hating me without cause, let them not wink the eye. (Psalms 35:19)

[Question] How did the Psalmist prophesy about how Yehowah God's Messiah would be treated, and why?

Those hating me without a cause have become even more than the hairs of my head. Those bringing me to silence, being my enemies for no reason, have become numerous. What I had not taken by robbery, I then proceeded to give back. (Psalms 69:4)

[Question] How did the Psalmist show, how those hating God's Messiah would multiply, and why would they hate him?

4. The third time he said to them; Why, what bad thing did this man do? I found nothing deserving of death in him. I will therefore chastise and release him. (Luke 23:22)

[Question] What did Pilate even find hard to understand, as reflected in his several comments to the assembled crowds?

5. For I was in fact kidnapped from the land of the Hebrews, and here also, I have done nothing at all, for which they should put me in the prison hole. (Genesis 40:15)

[Question] How was faithful Joseph treated, and did he deserve this treatment?

And he proceeded to put his soul in his palm, and strike the Philistine down, so that Yehowah performed a great salvation for all Israel. You saw it, and you gave way to rejoicing. So why should you sin against innocent blood, in having David put to death for nothing? (1 Samuel 19:5)

[Question] How did Saul sin, for why did he want to kill David?

7. And with words of hatred they have surrounded me, and they keep fighting against me without cause. (Psalms 109:3)

[Question] How did the Psalmist show, how men would feel about, and treat, Yehowah God's Messiah?

8' Princes themselves have persecuted me for no cause, but my heart has been in dread of your own words. (Psalms 119:161)

[Question] How did the Psalmist feel, when persecuted for righteousness sake?

9. Pilate said to him; What is truth? And after saying this, he went out again to the Jews and said to them; I find no fault in him. (John 18:38)

[Question] What did Pilate say in response to Jesus statement, that Jesus came to bear witness to the truth?

[Question] What could Pilate not find in Jesus?
