John 15:27~ And you, in turn, are to bear witness, because you have been with me from when I began.

1. They, in turn, as his disciples, were expected to bear witness to Jesus Christ, because they had been the ones that were with him from the beginning of his ministry.

[Question] What are anointed Christians expected to bear witness to, and why?

2. Just as those, who from the beginning, became eyewitnesses and attendants of the message, delivered these to us. (Luke 1:2)

[Question] From whom, did Luke compile his gospel of Jesus' life?

3. You are to be witnesses of these things. (Luke 24:48)

[Question] What did Jesus tell two of his disciples, that they must become, and does this apply to all Christians?

4. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit arrives upon you, and you will be witnesses of me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the most distant part of the earth. (Acts of Apostles 1:8)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples that they would receive when the Holy Spirit came upon them, and then what work would they do, and where?

5. Men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus the Nazarene, a man publicly shown by God to you, through powerful works and portents and signs, that God did through him in your midst, just as you yourselves know. (Acts of Apostles 2:22)

[Question] How did Yehowah God make his Son manifest to the people of Israel?

6. And we are witnesses of these matters, and so is the Holy Spirit, which God has given to those obeying him as ruler. (Acts of Apostles 5:32)

[Question] Who does Yehowah God give his Holy Spirit to?

7 Therefore, to the older men among you, I give this exhortation, for I too am an older man with them, and a

witness of the sufferings of the Christ, a sharer even of the glory, that is to be revealed. (1 Peter 5:1)

[Question] What did Peter show, that he himself was to become a sharer in, along with many others?

8' It is therefore necessary that of the men that assembled with us during all the time in which the Lord Jesus went in and out among us. (Acts of Apostles 1:21)

[Question] Who did Peter later show, should become an apostle to replace Judas Iscariot who betrayed Jesus?

9. That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have viewed attentively and our hands felt, concerning the word of life. (1 John 1:1)

[Question] How did John bear witness to this one the Messiah?
