

John 15:3~ You are already clean because of the word that I have spoken to you.

1· Then Jesus told his disciples, that they were clean, because of their acceptance of the word, that he had spoken to them. Therefore, hearing the word, and accepting it, and putting it into practice, is what sanctifies or makes Christians holy in God's sight. Persons who have not bathed in the light of the scriptures, are unclean, and will always remain so. You cannot do God's will, until you accurately know what it is.

[Question] What made the remaining disciples of Jesus clean?

[Question] What then, do anointed Christians do, that makes them clean in God's sight, and fit for his service?

[Question] What are all people who do not study the scriptures, and how long will they remain that way?

[Question] Who cannot be properly served, without accurate knowledge?

2· Jesus said to him; He that has bathed does not need to **have** more than his feet washed, but is wholly **clean**. And you men are **clean**, but not all. (**John 13:10**)

[Question] What washing externally did Jesus state, made one wholly clean?

3· Sanctify them by means of the truth. Your **word** is truth. (**John 17:17**)

[Question] What sanctifies or cleanses anointed Christians spiritually inside, and where do we find God's truth?

4· And he made no distinction at all between us and them, but purified their hearts by faith. (**Acts of Apostles 15:9**)

[Question] Does Yehowah God make any distinction between Jews and Gentiles today, who exercise faith in Christ?

5· Now that you **have** purified your souls, by your obedience to the truth, with unhypocritical brotherly affection as the result, love one another intensely from the heart. (**1 Peter 1:22**)

[Question] What fruit comes forth from purifying our souls by obedience to God's truth, found in his word the Bible?

- 6· **Furthermore, I washed you with water and rinsed away your blood from off you, and greased you with oil. (Ezekiel 16:9)**

[Question] How did Yehowah God show through Ezekiel, how he had cleansed his people Israel?

- 7· **And, look! There was a wall outside the house all round about. And in the hand of the man there was the measuring reed of six cubits, by a cubit and a handbreadth. And he began to measure the breadth of the thing built, one reed, and the height, one reed. (Ezekiel 40:5)**

[Question] What wall exists outside of the visionary temple, and what separation does it make, between clean and unclean things?

- 8· **This means everlasting life, their taking in knowledge of you, the only true God, and of the one whom you sent forth, Jesus Christ. (John 17:3)**

[Question] What means everlasting life for men today, and where will they find this accurate knowledge of Yehowah God and his Christ?
