John 15:9~ Just as the Father has loved me, and I have loved you, remain in my love.

1. So Jesus told then, that just as the Father had loved him, and just as he had loved them, that they should love one another, and thus remain in his love.

[Question] How did Jesus reflect to his disciples, the love Yehowah God had for him, and who should they also show this love to?

2. The Father loves the Son, and has given all things into his hand. (John 3:35)

[Question] Why has Yehowah God given all things into the hands of his Christ?

3. Now, because he knew before the festival of the Passover, that his hour had come, for him to move out of this world to the Father, Jesus, having loved his own that were in the world, loved them to the end. (John 13:1)

[Question] How did Jesus love his disciples right up to the end of his life on earth?

4. I am giving you a new commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you, that you also, love one another. (John 13:34)

[Question] How did Jesus want his disciples to love one another?

5. And I have made your name known to them, and will make it known, in order, that the love with which you loved me, may be in them, and I in union with them. (John 17:26)

[Question] What did Jesus make known to his disciples, though the Jews superstitiously chose not to use it, and what would this bring to them?

6 And from Jesus Christ, the Faithful Witness, the firstborn from the dead, and The Ruler of the kings of the earth. To him that loves us, and that loosed us from our sins, by means of his own blood. (Revelation 1:5)

[Question] What roles does Jesus Christ fill, and what has he done for mankind?
