

John 16:11~ Then concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world has been judged.

1· Then it would also bear witness concerning judgment, because the ruler of the world had been judged, when Christ was resurrected from an unjust death. Then, when the Holy Spirit was poured out, they would know for certainty, that Jesus was alive with his heavenly Father in heaven. Not all of his disciples would see him after his resurrection, but all would have the spirit to bear witness to them, of his living before his God in heaven.

[Question] What then, would the Holy Spirit bear witness to, for who is judged by Christ being raised from the dead?

[Question] What would Jesus' disciples know for a certainty, after the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon them?

[Question] Why was this necessary?

2· Look! My servant, on whom I keep fast hold! My chosen one, whom my soul **has** approved! I have put my spirit in him. Justice to the nations is what he will bring forth. **(Isaiah 42:1)**

[Question] What did Yehowah God promise to put upon his servant, and what then would this one make known to the nations?

3· Look! My servant whom I chose, my beloved, whom my soul approved! I will put my spirit upon him, and what justice is, he will make clear to the nations. **(Matthew 12:18)**

[Question] What would this Messianic servant make know to the nations, for what was upon him from Yehowah God?

4· He that exercises faith in him, is not to be **judged**. He that does not exercise faith, **has** been **judged** already, because he **has** not exercised faith, in the name of the only-begotten Son of God. **(John 3:18)**

[Question] Will the man who exercises faith in Jesus Christ ever be judged?

[Question] What is the standing judgment, against anyone who refuses to accept Christ?

5· Now there is a judging of this **world**, now the **ruler** of this

world will be cast out. (John 12:31)

[Question] What happens when there is a judging of this world, for who is then cast out?

- 6· **I shall not speak much with you anymore, for the ruler of the world is coming. And he has no hold on me. (John 14:30)**

[Question] Who did Jesus identify, as the current ruler of the world, and was Jesus affected by this one?

- 7· **And it must occur in that day that Yehowah will turn his attention upon the army of the height in the height, and upon the kings of the ground upon the ground. (Isaiah 24:21)**

[Question] Who then, will Yehowah God turn his attention to in judgment, who now rules unseen over this present system of things?

[Question] Who also, who are seen, will he turn his attention toward?

- 8· **On its boughs all the flying creatures of the heavens made their nests, and under its branches all the wild beasts of the field gave birth, and in its shade, all the populous nations would dwell. (Ezekiel 31:6)**

[Question] Who nests upon the branches of this great tree, and what do they represent?

- 9· **At that he said to them, I began to behold Satan already fallen like lightning from heaven. (Luke 10:18)**

[Question] What did Jesus figuratively see, upon his apostles returning and expressing their great joy, that they had power over the demons?
