

John 16:13~ However, when that one¹ arrives, the spirit of the truth, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak of his own impulse, but what things he hears, he will speak, and he will declare to you the things coming.

Footnote: That one Masculine, referring to the helper Masculine, in (John 16:7)

1· Then Jesus spoke again about the helper, the spirit of the truth that he would send to them, for it would guide them into all the truth. This spirit of the truth would not speak of any inward impulse, but it would speak to them the things that God wanted them to know, and it would declare to them the things that were coming, before they came. They could therefore always depend upon this spirit of the truth, for it would always be true and dependable.

[Question] What did Jesus then tell them that this helper, the spirit of the truth, would do for them?

[Question] Who would direct what this helper told them and taught them?

[Question] What things would they learn before they happened?

[Question] Why then, is it called the spirit of the truth?

2· Nevertheless, I am telling you the **truth**. It is for your benefit I am going away. For if I do not go away, the helper **will** by no means come to **you**, but if I do go my way, I **will** send him to you. (**John 16:7**)

[Question] What truth did Jesus share with his disciples, that would come to them, only when he went away to heaven?

3· One of them named Agabus rose and proceeded to indicate through the **spirit**, that a great famine was about to come upon the entire inhabited earth, which, for that matter, did take place, in the time of Claudius. (**Acts of Apostles 11:28**)

[Question] What future event did Agabus foretell through the guidance of the Holy Spirit some eight years later in the days of emperor Claudius?

4· Moreover, they went through Phrygia and the country of Galatia, because they were forbidden by the Holy Spirit, to **speak** the word in the district of Asia. (**Acts of Apostles**)

16:6)

[Question] Where did Paul preach, and why did Paul not enter the district of Asia?

- 5· And he came to us and took up the girdle of Paul, bound his **own** feet and hands and said; Thus says the Holy Spirit; The man to whom this girdle belongs, the Jews **will** bind in this manner in Jerusalem, and deliver into the hands of people of the nations. (**Acts of Apostles 21:11**)

[Question] How did the prophet Agabus foretell trouble ahead for the apostle Paul?

- 6· However, the inspired utterance says definitely, that in later periods of time, some **will** fall away from the faith, paying attention to misleading inspired utterances, and teachings of demons. (**1 Timothy 4:1**)

[Question] What did the inspired utterance of the Holy Spirit tell Paul that was coming upon anointed Christians at a future time?

- 7· And upon him, the **spirit** of Yehowah must settle down, the **spirit** of wisdom and of understanding, the **spirit** of counsel, and of mightiness, the **spirit** of knowledge, and of the fear of Yehowah. (**Isaiah 11:2**)

[Question] How did Isaiah prophesy about this Messianic servant, and what would come upon him?

[Question] What would settle down upon this Messianic servant through the operation of the Holy Spirit?

- 8· The **spirit** of the **truth**, which the world cannot receive, because it neither beholds it nor knows it. You know it, because it remains with you and is in you. (**John 14:17**)

[Question] Why does the world in general not believe in a Holy Spirit?

[Question] Why do spirit anointed Christians believe in it, is it a matter of faith, or a reality of their daily lives?

- 9· But the helper, the Holy Spirit, which the Father **will** send in my name, that one **will** teach you all **things**, and bring back to your minds all the **things** I told you. (**John 14:26**)

[Question] What did Jesus promise, that the Holy Spirit would do for his disciples?

- 10· So the **spirit** told me to go with them, not doubting at all. But these six brothers also went with me, and we entered into the house of the man. (**Acts of Apostles 11:12**)

[Question] Who told Peter to enter into the house of the Gentile man, Cornelius?

- 11· For the Holy Spirit and we ourselves, have favored adding no further burden to you, except these necessary **things**. (**Acts of Apostles 15:28**)

[Question] What decree did the Holy Spirit concur upon, along with the apostles?

- 12· These **things** we also **speak**, not with words taught by human wisdom, but with those taught by the **spirit**, as we combine spiritual matters with spiritual words. (**1 Corinthians 2:13**)

[Question] What words do spirit anointed Christians use, and who teaches these words to them?

[Question] What matters of the Holy Spirit do anointed Christians try to put into words, and is this always possible to do?

- 13· And as for you, the anointing that you received from him remains in you, and you do not need anyone to be teaching **you**, but, as the anointing from him is teaching you about all **things**, and is true, and is no lie, and just as it has taught you, remain in union with him. (**1 John 2:27**)

[Question] What remains within all faithful true anointed Christians, and why do they not need anyone else to teach them the truth?
