Jesus knew they were wanting to question him, so he said to them; Are you inquiring among yourselves over this, because I said; In a little while you will not behold me, and, again, in a little while you will see me?

1. Jesus knew that they were wanting to question him about this, so he asked then, why they were inquiring among themselves about his previous statement, of a little while, before he would leave them and then see them again.

[Question] What did Jesus know about them, after making this statement?

2. And because he was in no need to have anyone bear witness about man, for he himself knew what was in man. (John 2:25)

[Question] What was Jesus in no need to have borne witness to him, because he could read men's thoughts?

3. However, they were not understanding the saying, and they were afraid to question him. (Mark 9:32)

[Question] How did Jesus disciples earlier feel, when not understanding something he said?
