- 1· Jesus knew that they were wanting to question him about this, so he asked then, why they were inquiring among themselves about his previous statement, of a little while, before he would leave them and then see them again.

[Question] What did Jesus know about them, after making this statement?

- 2· And because he was in no need to have anyone bear witness about man, for he himself knew what was in man. (John 2:25)

[Question] What was Jesus in no need to have borne witness to him, because he could read men's thoughts?

- 3· However, they were not understanding the saying, and they were afraid to question him. (Mark 9:32)

[Question] How did Jesus disciples earlier feel, when not understanding something he said?
