John 16:24~ Until this present time you have not asked a single thing in my name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be made full.

1. So Jesus told them, that though he had told them of this ability before this, that not one of them had so far gone to the Father in prayer, and asked for a single thing. So he told them to ask, that their joy might be made full.

[Question] What did Jesus now show, that they had the opportunity to do, but had not yet exercised?

[Question] What did Jesus tell them they would experience, if they did ask?

2. These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you and your joy may be made full. (John 15:11)

[Question] Why did Jesus tell his disciples these things, before leaving to go to the Father?

3. And so we are writing these things, that our joy may be in full measure. (1 John 1:4)

[Question] Why also did John and Peter and others write down what true Christian faith is, for future generations of Christians?

4. The thing frightful to the wicked one, that is what will come to him, but the desire of the righteous ones will be granted. (Proverbs 10:24)

[Question] Whose desire will be granted according to the Proverb?

5. Again I truly say to you, if two of you on earth agree concerning anything of importance, that they should request, it will take place for them, due to my Father in heaven. (Matthew 18:19)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples would occur for them, if two or more of them agreed upon anything of importance?

6. This is why I tell you, all the things you pray and ask for, have faith that you have practically received, and you will have them. (Mark 11:24)

[Question] How should anointed Christians feel, about any request pending before Yehowah God, that they have previously made?
