

John 16:27~ For the Father himself has affection for you, because you have had affection for me, and have believed, that I came out, as the Father's representative.

1· The reason Christ would not have to represent them then before the Father, was because the Father himself had affection for them, because they had demonstrated affection for his beloved son, and believed, that Jesus had come out, as his heavenly Father's direct representative.

[Question] What would the Father then openly show his spirit anointed sons directly, that he had for them, and why would he do this?

2· He that **has** my commandments and observes them, that one is he who loves me. In turn, he that loves me, will be loved by my Father, and I will love him, and will plainly show myself to him. (**John 14:21**)

[Question] Who did Jesus state, was the one that truly loved him, and how does Yehowah God also feel about all such ones?

3· Moreover, no man **has** ascended into heaven, but he that descended from heaven, the Son of man. (**John 3:13**)

[Question] Who is the only man, that has yet ascended to heaven?

4· Because the sayings that you gave me, I **have** given to them, and they **have** received them, and **have** certainly come to know, that I **came out** as your **representative**, and they **have believed**, that you sent me forth. (**John 17:8**)

[Question] What did Jesus' disciples come to know about the origin of the sayings Jesus spoke, and what did they see Jesus as?

5· Jesus said to them; If God were your Father, you would love me, for from God I **came** forth, and am here. Neither **have** I come of my own initiative at all, but that One sent me forth. (**John 8:42**)

[Question] Why should men who claim to love Yehowah God, also love the Christ, for who sent forth the Christ?
