

John 16:28~ I came out from the Father and have come into the world. Further, I am leaving the world, and am going my way to the Father.

1· Jesus then told them plainly, that he had come forth into their world directly from the Father, and that upon leaving their world, he was to return to the Father.

[Question] Where did Jesus tell them, that he had come forth from, and where would he soon be returning to?

2· You must also hear from the heavens, your established place of dwelling, their prayer, and their request for favor, and you must execute judgment for them. (1 Kings 8:49)

[Question] Where is the established place of Yehowah God's dwelling, and what does he hear from there?

3· Yehowah is in his holy temple. Yehowah, in the heavens is his throne. His own eyes behold, his own beaming eyes, examine the sons of men. (Psalms 11:4)

[Question] Where is the throne of Yehowah God, and what does he behold about mankind, and examine continuously?

4· He, knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he came forth from God, and was going to God. (John 13:3)

[Question] What did Jesus know about his relationship to Yehowah God?

5· For Christ entered, not into a holy place made with hands, which is a copy of the reality, but into heaven itself, now, to appear before the person of God for us. (Hebrews 9:24)

[Question] How did Jesus act as a High Priest, and what tent did he enter to make atonement for mankind?

6· O sword, awake against my shepherd, even against the able-bodied man who is my associate, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies. Strike the shepherd, and let those of the flock be scattered, and I shall certainly turn my hand back, upon those who are insignificant. (Zechariah 13:7)

[Question] What did Zechariah prophesy would happen to this shepherd, and what would awake toward him?

[Question] What then, would happen to all his flock, until when?

- 7· **In answer Jesus said to them; Even if I do bear witness about myself, my witness is true, because I know where I came from, and where I am going. But you do not know where I came from, and where I am going. (John 8:14)**

[Question] Why could Jesus state that his witness, though singular, was true?

[Question] What though, did people hearing him, not realize about his origins?

- 8· **So he went on to say to them; You are from the realms below. I am from the realms above. You are from this world. I am not from this world. (John 8:23)**

[Question] Where did Jesus state, that his origin was from, as opposed to other men?

- 9· **Now, because he knew before the festival of the Passover, that his hour had come for him to move out of this world, to the Father, Jesus, having loved his own that were in the world, loved them to the end. (John 13:1)**

[Question] What did Jesus know, even before the Passover of 33 C.E.?

[Question] How then, did Jesus treat his faithful disciples right up to the end?

- 10· **Jesus said to her; Stop clinging to me. For I have not yet ascended to the Father. But be on your way to my brothers and say to them, I am ascending to my Father and your Father and to my God and your God. (John 20:17)**

[Question] How did Mary react upon realizing that Jesus had been resurrected, and what did Jesus tell her to convey to his apostles?
