

**John 16:30~** Now, we know, that you know all things, and you do not need to have anyone question you. By this, we believe, that you came out from God.

1· So they replied, that now they knew that he knew all things, and did not need to have anyone question him. Now they believed, that he came forth from God.

**[Question]** What then, did this convince them of about Jesus?

2· He said to him the third time; Simon son of John, do you **have** affection for me? Peter became grieved that he said to him the third time; Do you **have** affection for me? So he said to him; Lord, you **know** all **things**, you are aware that I **have** affection for you. Jesus said to him; Feed my little sheep. (**John 21:17**)

**[Question]** How did Peter come to feel, when Jesus asked him, if he had affection for him?

**[Question]** What did Jesus counsel Peter to continue doing, if he loved him?

3· And because he was in no **need** to **have anyone** bear witness about man, for he himself knew, what was in man. (**John 2:25**)

**[Question]** What was Jesus in no need of hearing from others, for what did he know firsthand about men?

4· Because the sayings that you gave me, I **have** given to them, and they **have** received them, and **have** certainly come to **know**, that I **came out** as your representative, and they **have** believed, that you sent me forth. (**John 17:8**)

**[Question]** Whose saying did Jesus relay to his disciples, and what did this information prove to them?
