- 1· **Yet Jesus could see, that his words were having the effect of filling his disciples' hearts, with grief.**

[Question] How did Jesus words about going away, then affect his disciples, as he bore witness to them?

- 2· **And they will kill him, and the third day he will be raised up. Consequently they were very much grieved. (Matthew 17:23)**

[Question] What did Jesus state, that the Jewish religious leaders would do to him, and then what would happen?

- 3· **Do not let your hearts be troubled. Exercise faith in God, exercise faith also in me. (John 14:1)**

[Question] How did Jesus not want his disciples to feel over his upcoming death, and what did they need to exercise to get safely through this trying time?

- 4· **You also, therefore, are now, indeed, having grief. But I shall see you again and your hearts will rejoice, and your joy, no one will take from you. (John 16:22)**

[Question] What did Jesus show, that his disciples were experiencing right then, but how would they come to feel after his resurrection?
