[Question] What did Jesus state, that the Jewish religious leaders would do to him, and then what would happen?

3. Do not let your hearts be troubled. Exercise faith in God, exercise faith also in me. (John 14:1)

[Question] How did Jesus not want his disciples to feel over his upcoming death, and what did they need to exercise to get safely through this trying time?

4' You also, therefore, are now, indeed, having grief. But I shall see you again and your hearts will rejoice, and your joy, no one will take from you. (John 16:22)

[Question] What did Jesus show, that his disciples were experiencing right then, but how would they come to feel after his resurrection?
