John 16:8~ And when that one arrives he will give the world convincing evidence concerning sin, and concerning righteousness, and concerning judgment.

Footnote: Will give convincing evidence Or, will reprove Greek, e-leg'xei

1. Jesus then showed, that when the helper, the Holy Spirit arrived, that it would bear witness to them concerning sin, and righteousness and also judgment.

[Question] What would the helper the Holy Spirit, give convincing evidence about?

2. He that disregards me and does not receive my sayings, has one to judge him. The word that I have spoken, is what will judge him in the last day. (John 12:48)

[Question] Who will judge the one, who refuses to accept the sayings of Jesus Christ?

3. But as he talked about righteousness and self-control, and the judgment to come, Felix became frightened and answered; For the present go your way, but when I get an opportune time I shall send for you again. (Acts of Apostles 24:25)

[Question] How did Governor Felix feel upon hearing the fine witness of the apostle Paul?

4. And the nations will certainly see your righteousness, O woman, and all kings your glory. And you will actually be called by a new name, which the very mouth of Yehowah will designate. (Isaiah 62:2)

[Question] What would God's woman become manifest to the nations, and what would they see about her?

[Question] Who will then give his woman a new name?

5. All Scripture is inspired of God and beneficial for teaching, for reproving, for setting things straight, for disciplining in righteousness. (2 Timothy 3:16)

[Question] Who inspired all the writings of the Bible record, and what are they useful for?
