1· Jesus then told his heavenly Father, that he had given the same word to them, that Yehowah God had given to him. Also, that because of this word, the world around them hated them, because they were now no part of the world, just as he was no part of the world.

[Question] What word did Jesus show, that he had given to his disciples?

[Question] How now did the world around his disciples feel about them, and why, after their receiving this word of God?

2· Do not marvel, brothers, that the world hates you. (1 John 3:13)

[Question] What did John tell other disciples not to marvel over?

3· So he went on to say to them; You are from the realms below. I am from the realms above. You are from this world. I am not from this world. (John 8:23)

[Question] What made Jesus very different than all other men?

4· If you were part of the world, the world would be fond of what is its own. Now, because you are no part of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, on this account the world hates you. (John 15:19)

[Question] What would the world be fond of, but why is it not fond of Christians?

5· Adulteresses, do you not know, that the friendship with the world, is enmity with God? Whoever, therefore, wants to be a friend of the world, is constituting himself an enemy of God. (James 4:4)

[Question] What does Yehowah God consider anyone to be, who loves this current world and its wickedness?

6· Happy are you, whenever men hate you, and whenever they exclude you, and reproach you, and cast out your name as wicked, for the sake of the Son of man. (Luke

6:22)

[Question] How should anointed Christians feel, when the world rejects them?

7· If the **world** hates you, you know that it **has hated** me before it **hated** you. (**John 15:18**)

[Question] Who did the world hate, because it hated him first?

8· It is sown in dishonor, it is raised up in glory. It is sown in weakness, it is raised up in power. (**1 Corinthians 15:43**)

[Question] How is the physical body sown, and then how is it raised up?
