

John 17:15~ I request you, not to take them out of the world, but to watch over them, because of the wicked one.

- 1· So then, Jesus asked his heavenly Father, not to take them out of the world, but to watch over them in his behalf, because of the wicked one, Satan the Devil, whose hand they were to be given over to, that very night for testing.

[Question] What did Jesus then ask of his heavenly Father respecting his own disciples?

[Question] Into whose hand, would they be given over to that very night for testing?

- 2· And do not bring us into temptation, but deliver us from the wicked one. (**Matthew 6:13**)

[Question] What did Jesus ask of Yehowah God in the Model Prayer?

- 3· But the Lord is faithful, and he will make you firm, and keep you from the wicked one. (**2 Thessalonians 3:3**)

[Question] How dependable are Jesus Christ and Yehowah God, and what will they keep anointed Christians from?

- 4· We know, that every person that has been born from God, does not practice sin, but the One born from God watches him, and the wicked one does not fasten his hold on him. (**1 John 5:18**)

[Question] What does the one born from Yehowah God not practice?

[Question] Who then, watches over these ones, and who will he not allow to get a hold, on any of them?

- 5· But I have made supplication for you, that your faith may not give out, and you, when once you have returned, strengthen your brothers. (**Luke 22:32**)

[Question] What supplication did Jesus make for his disciples before this night of severe testing, and to what end?

- 6· Not meaning entirely with the fornicators of this world, or the greedy persons, and extortioners, or idolaters. Otherwise, you would actually have to get out of the world. (**1 Corinthians 5:10**)

[Question] What contact can anointed Christians not cut out entirely, for what would be required to do that?

[Question] What kinds of persons though, should we try to avoid if possible as associates, though not in our ministry?
