

John 17:17~

Sanctify them by means of the truth. Your word is truth.

1· Jesus then asked Yehowah God to sanctify his disciples by means of the truth. Yehowah God's word was truth, not only the inspired scriptures, but also every word coming forth from his mouth, and closely following this word, would keep them clean in his sight.

[Question] What did Jesus ask Yehowah God to sanctify his disciples through, and what two avenues does this take?

2· And he made no distinction at all between us and them, but purified their hearts by faith. (**Acts of Apostles 15:9**)

[Question] What two groups are both sanctified through their faith in Yehowah God?

3· That he might sanctify it, cleansing it with the bath of water by means of the word. (**Ephesians 5:26**)

[Question] How does this sanctification come to spirit anointed Christians?

4· May the very God of peace sanctify you completely. And sound in every respect, may the spirit and soul and body of you brothers be, preserved in a blameless manner, at the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ. (**1 Thessalonians 5:23**)

[Question] How do spirit anointed Christians want to be able to appear when coming before the judgment seat of Christ during his presence?

5· However, we are obligated to thank God always for you, brothers, loved by Yehowah, because God selected you from the beginning for salvation, by sanctifying you with spirit, and by your faith in the truth. (**2 Thessalonians 2:13**)

[Question] Who selected all of his spirit anointed Christian sons, and how does he sanctify them for his clean service?

6· Now that you have purified your souls, by your obedience to the truth, with unhypocritical brotherly affection as the result, love one another intensely from the heart. (**1 Peter 1:22**)

[Question] What results from obedience to the truth for spirit anointed Christians?

- 7· Keeping a tight grip on the **word** of life, that I may have cause for exultation in Christ's day, that I did not run in vain, or work hard in vain. (**Philippians 2:16**)

[Question] What should all spirit anointed Christians keep a tight hold of, for what do they not want to work hard for, in vain?

- 8· The sayings of Yehowah are pure sayings, as silver refined in a smelting furnace of earth, clarified seven times. (**Psalms 12:6**)

[Question] What are the sayings of Yehowah God likened to by the Psalmist?

- 9· You are near, O Yehowah, and all your commandments are **truth**. (**Psalms 119:151**)

[Question] What are all the commandments of Yehowah God?

- 10· The substance of your **word** is **truth**, and every righteous judicial decision of yours is to time indefinite. (**Psalms 119:160**)

[Question] What is the substance of Yehowah God's word the Bible?

- 11· Because he willed it, he brought us forth by the **word** of **truth**, for us to be certain firstfruits of his creatures. (**James 1:18**)

[Question] Who will the bringing forth of his spirit anointed sons, and how did he bring them forth, and what are they now among all the human family?

- 12· As for you, speak to the sons of Israel, saying; Especially my Sabbaths you are to keep, for it is a sign between me and you during your generations, that you may know, that I, Yehowah, am sanctifying you. (**Exodus 31:13**)

[Question] What would the keeping of the Sabbath, teach the Israelites over many generations?

- 13· And you must not profane my holy name, and I must be sanctified in the midst of the sons of Israel. I am Yehowah, who is sanctifying you. (**Leviticus 22:32**)

[Question] How is Yehowah God to be viewed among his people, and what does he impart to his faithful people?

- 14· **And now, O Sovereign Lord Yehowah, you are the true God, and as for your words, let them prove to be truth, since you promise to your servant this goodness. (2 Samuel 7:28)**

[Question] How did the prophet David feel about the sayings of Yehowah God, and his way?

- 15· **Your saying is very much refined, and your own servant loves it. (Psalms 119:140)**

[Question] How did the Psalmist show his appreciation for the word of God?

- 16· **Your righteousness is a righteousness to time indefinite, and your Law is truth. (Psalms 119:142)**

[Question] What did the Psalmist show, that God's Law was?

- 17· **For my palate in low tones utters truth itself, and wickedness is something detestable to my lips. (Proverbs 8:7)**

[Question] What did the congregator utter in low tones daily?

- 18· **The congregator sought to find the delightful words and the writing of correct words of truth. (Ecclesiastes 12:10)**

[Question] What did the congregator seek to find and write down?

- 19· **Therefore speak with them and you must say to them; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Any man at all of the house of Israel that brings up his dungy idols upon his heart, and that places the very stumbling block causing his error in front of his face and that actually comes to the prophet, I, Yehowah, I will let myself be brought to answer him in the matter, according to the multitude of his dungy idols. (Ezekiel 14:4)**

[Question] Would Yehowah God deal well with anyone who used idols and also inquired of his true prophets?

- 20· **For any man at all from the house of Israel, or from the alien residents that reside as aliens in Israel, that withdraws himself from following me, and that brings up**

his dungy idols upon his heart, and that sets the very stumbling block causing his error in front of his face, and that actually comes to the prophet to make inquiry for himself by me. I, Yehowah, I am letting myself be brought to answer him by myself. (**Ezekiel 14:7**)

[Question] What did Yehowah God feel towards anyone following after idols?

- 21· And no falsehood was found in their mouths, they are without blemish. (**Revelation 14:5**)

[Question] What is not found, within the mouths of conquering spirit anointed Christians?

- 22· And they will no longer defile themselves with their dungy idols, and with their disgusting things, and with all their transgressions, and I shall certainly save them from all their dwelling places, in which they have sinned, and I will cleanse them, and they must become my people, and I myself shall become their God. (**Ezekiel 37:23**)

[Question] What would Yehowah God's people no longer follow after, upon returning to their homeland after the exile?

- 23· And you will know the **truth**, and the **truth** will set you free. (**John 8:32**)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples, that they would come to know, and how would they fare through knowing the truth accurately?

- 24· You are already clean, because of the **word** that I have spoken to you. (**John 15:3**)

[Question] How does the word of God make one before Yehowah God, if it is accepted in one's heart upon hearing it?

- 25· Consequently let us keep the festival, not with old leaven, neither with leaven of badness and wickedness, but with unfermented cakes of sincerity and **truth**. (**1 Corinthians 5:8**)

[Question] How should spirit anointed Christians keep the festival of unfermented cakes, in a spiritual way?

- 26· And as for you, the anointing that you received from him remains in you, and you do not need anyone to be teaching

you, but as the anointing from him is teaching you about all things, and is true and is no lie, and just as it has taught you, remain in union with him. (1 John 2:27)

[Question] What remains within spirit anointed Christians, that teaches them continually?

[Question] Is this spirit always true?

27· Because of the truth that remains in us, and it will be with us forever. (2 John 1:2)

[Question] What remains within spirit anointed Christians, and will this always be the case?

28· And they conquered him because of the blood of the Lamb, and because of the word of their witnessing, and they did not love their souls, even in the face of death. (Revelation 12:11)

[Question] How do spirit anointed Christians conquer, and what do they not love, even when facing death?
