John 17:19~ And I am sanctifying myself<sup>1</sup> in their behalf, that they also may be sanctified by means of truth.

1. So then Jesus told his Father, that he was sanctifying himself in their behalf, so that they might also be sanctified by means of the truth. Therefore men cannot be clean before Yehowah God, without true knowledge of God, and who and what he is. If we believe lies or falsehoods, then we are unclean before God.

[Question] What did Jesus then show, that he was doing, and what would sanctify his disciples?

[Question] Can men be clean before their God, without accurate knowledge of his will and purpose?

[Question] If men believe lies and falsehoods about Yehowah God and his Christ, and they be clean before their God?

2. For God called us, not with allowance for uncleanness, but in connection with sanctification. (1 Thessalonians 4:7)

[Question] What is the purpose of Yehowah God in calling his spirit anointed Christian sons?

3. By the said, will, we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all time. (Hebrews 10:10)

[Question] By means of whose will are spirit anointed Christians sanctified, and through what offering?

4. To the congregation of God that is in Corinth, to you who have been sanctified in union with Christ Jesus, called to be holy ones, together with all who everywhere are calling upon the name of our Lord, Jesus Christ, their Lord and ours. (1 Corinthians 1:2)

[Question] What are spirit anointed Christians called to become before their God?

5. But it is due to him that you are in union with Christ Jesus, who has become to us, wisdom from God, also righteousness, and sanctification, and release by ransom.

## (1 Corinthians 1:30)

[Question] Whose will is it according to, that spirit anointed Christians are in union with Christ?

[Question] What has the Christ become, to all spirit anointed Christians?

6 For this is what God wills, the sanctifying of you, that you abstain from fornication. (1 Thessalonians 4:3)

[Question] What is God's will for spirit anointed Christians, and what must they abstain from?

7' For both he who is sanctifying, and those who are being sanctified, all stem from one, and for this cause, he is not ashamed to call them, brothers. (Hebrews 2:11)

[Question] Where do both Christ and all his spirit anointed Christian brothers spring from, and so how does Christ feel about these ones?

8. Hence Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered outside the gate. (Hebrews 13:12)
