- John 17:2~ According as you have given him authority over all flesh, that, as regards the whole number whom you have given him, he may give them everlasting life.
 - 1. So Jesus then showed, that according to power and authority given him by Yehowah God, he would give to the whole number putting faith in him, everlasting life.
 - [Question] What power did Jesus then have, from whom, and what could he do with this power?
 - 2. And to him there were given rulership and dignity and kingdom, that the peoples, national groups and languages, should all serve even him. His rulership is an indefinitely lasting rulership, that will not pass away, and his kingdom, one, that will not be brought to ruin. (Daniel 7:14)
 - [Question] What does the vision of Daniel show, that the Son of Man will be given, and how long will he rule for?
 - 3. And Jesus approached and spoke to them, saying; All authority has been given me in heaven and on the earth. (Matthew 28:18)
 - [Question] What did Jesus tell his apostles, just before ascending to the heavens to be with Yehowah God?
 - 4. For he must rule as king, until God has put all enemies under his feet (1 Corinthians 15:25)
 - [Question] How long must Jesus rule as king of all the earth, and what will be the situation at the end of that time?
 - 5. So that in the name of Jesus, every knee should bend, of those in heaven, and those on earth, and those under the ground. (Philippians 2:10)
 - [Question] How should every knee respond to the person of Jesus Christ?
 - 6. All things you subjected under his feet. For in that he subjected all things to him, God left nothing that is not subject to him. Now, though, we do not yet see all things in subjection to him. (Hebrews 2:8)

[Question] What things has Yehowah God subjected under the feet of his Christ?

[Question] What though, will never be subject to Jesus Christ?

[Question] Do we currently see this situation on earth?

7. Everything the Father gives me, will come to me, and the one that comes to me, I will by no means drive away. (John 6:37)

[Question] Who comes to Jesus, and how will he treat such ones?

8 Because of the trouble of his soul he will see, he will be satisfied. By means of his knowledge, the righteous one, my servant, will bring a righteous standing to many people, and their errors he himself will bear. (Isaiah 53:11)

[Question] By what means would Yehowah God's servant, bring a righteous standing to many people, and what would he bear in their behalf?

9. Whoever drinks from the water that I will give him, will never get thirsty at all, but the water that I will give him will become in him a fountain of water, bubbling up to impart everlasting life. (John 4:14)

[Question] What kind of spiritual water of truth did Jesus have to give to others, and what does it become, within anyone partaking of it?

10" Work, not for the food that perishes, but for the food that remains for life everlasting, which the Son of man will give you, for upon this one, the Father, even God, has put his seal of approval. (John 6:27)

[Question] What kind of food did Jesus tell his faithful disciples to work hard for, and why?

11. At the sight of this, the crowds were struck with fear, and they glorified God, who gave such authority to men.

(Matthew 9:8)

[Question] How did the crowds of people respond upon seeing Jesus' many signs and miracles?

12. All things have been delivered to me by my Father, and no one fully knows the Son, but the Father, neither does anyone fully know the Father, but the Son, and anyone, to

whom the Son is willing to reveal him. (Matthew 11:27)

[Question] What things has the Father delivered to his Son?

[Question] Who knows the Father better than any other man?

13. Take what is yours and go. I want to give to this last one the same as to you. (Matthew 20:14)

[Question] How did the householder in Jesus' illustration want to treat those eleventh hour workers, and what prompted this within him?

14. The Father loves the Son and has given all things into his hand. (John 3:35)

[Question] How does the Father feel about his Son, and so what has he given him?

15. And I give them everlasting life, and they will by no means ever be destroyed, and no one will snatch them out of my hand. (John 10:28)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his faithful disciples, that he would give to them, and would anyone ever be able to take this away from them?

16. What my Father has given me is something greater than all other things, and no one can snatch them out of the hand of the Father. (John 10:29)

[Question] Can anything be compared, to that which the Christ has been given by Yehowah God?

17. Also, I know that his commandment means everlasting life. Therefore the things I speak, just as the Father has told me them, so I speak them. (John 12:50)

[Question] What doing the commandment of Jesus Christ mean for faithful ones?
