John 17:22~ Also, I have given them the glory that you have given me, in order, that they may be one just as we are one.

1. Jesus had also given them the glory, that Yehowah God had given to his son, so that they would look forward to gaining heavenly life alongside of their creator, and his beloved Son, Jesus Christ. Jesus wanted them to all be in unity with his heavenly Father, just as he was.

[Question] What glory did Jesus give to his disciples, and to what end?

2. In that day, you will know that I am in union with my Father, and you are in union with me, and I am in union with you. (John 14:20)

[Question] When would spirit anointed Christians surely come to know, that Jesus Christ was in union with Yehowah God?

3. Also, I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, watch over them on account of your own name, which you have given me, in order, that they may be one, just as we are. (John 17:11)

[Question] Where would Jesus be leaving his disciples, and so what did he request Yehowah God do for them?

4. That which we have seen and heard, we are reporting also to you, that you too, may be having a sharing with us. Furthermore, this sharing of ours, is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ. (1 John 1:3)

[Question] Why did John and others keep telling out the Good News of God?

5. Moreover, he who observes his commandments remains in union with him, and he in union with such one, and by this, we gain the knowledge, that he is remaining in union with us, owing to the spirit which he gave us. (1 John 3:24)

[Question] Who remains in union with Jesus Christ?

[Question] What convinces spirit anointed Christians that Yehowah God and his Christ remain in union with them?

6. In like manner, notwithstanding, these men, too, indulging

in dreams, are defiling the flesh, and disregarding lordship, and speaking abusively of glorious ones. (Jude 1:8)

[Question] How did Jude speak against men who spoke against glorious ones?
