John 17:26~ And I have made your name known to them, and will make it known, in order, that the love with which you loved me, may be in them, and I, in union with them.

1. Also Jesus revealed that he had made Yehowah God's name known to his disciples, and would make it known further at a later time, so that the love with which Yehowah God loved his Son, may also be in them, and they would remain in union with Christ.

[Question] What did Jesus make known to his disciples, and to what end?

2. For I shall declare the name of Yehowah. Do you attribute greatness to our God! (Deuteronomy 32:3)

[Question] What did Moses state, that he would also declare, for what belongs to Yehowah God?

**3** You must pray, then, this way. Our Father in the heavens, let your name be sanctified. (Matthew 6:9)

[Question] How did Jesus show, how we should treat Yehowah God's name, in his Model Prayer?

4. I have made your name manifest to the men you gave me out of the world. They were yours, and you gave them to me, and they have observed your word. (John 17:6)

[Question] What name, did Jesus make manifest to his disciples?[Question] Whose word, did Jesus teach them to observe?

5. Just as the Father has loved me and I have loved you, remain in my love. (John 15:9)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples to remain in, through copying his own fine example?

6 Nor height nor depth nor any other creation, will be able to separate us from God's love, that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 8:39)

**[Question]** Will anything within creation be able to separate spirit anointed Christians from Christ's love?

7. To have the Christ dwell through your faith in your hearts,

with love, that you may be rooted, and established on the foundation. (Ephesians 3:17)

[Question]How should the Christ dwell within Christians hearts?[Question]What foundation must all Christians be built upon?

8. Nevertheless, Moses said to the true God; Suppose I am now come to the sons of Israel, and I do say to them; The God of your forefathers has sent me to you, and they do say to me; What is his name? What shall I say to them? (Exodus 3:13)

[Question] What question did Moses pose to Yehowah God, when going before his Israelite brothers?

9. O Yehowah our Lord, how majestic your name is in all the earth, you whose dignity is recounted above the heavens! (Psalms 8:1)

[Question] How did the Psalmist feel about the name of Yehowah God?

10. For that reason, my people will know my name, even for that reason, in that day, because I am the One that is speaking. Look! It is I. (Isaiah 52:6)

**[Question]** What had Isaiah told his people, that they would come to know in a future day?

11. We have for a long time become, as those, over whom you did not rule, as those, upon whom your name had not been called. (Isaiah 63:19)

[Question] What had the Israelites become like, even in Isaiah's day, because they had walked away from the teachings of the Bible?

12. When, now, they had breakfasted, Jesus said to Simon Peter; Simon son of John, do you love me more than these? He said to him; Yes, Lord, you know I have affection for you. He said to him; Feed my lambs. (John 21:15)

[Question] What did Jesus tell Peter to do, if he loved Jesus more than food?

13. The one that conquers, I will make him a pillar in the

temple of my God, and he will by no means go out from it anymore, and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, the new Jerusalem, which descends out of heaven from my God, and that new name of mine. (Revelation 3:12)

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell his disciples, that he would make of the one conquering, and what name would he write upon that one?
