

John 17:3~ This means everlasting life, their taking in knowledge of you,¹ the only true God, and of the one whom you sent forth, Jesus Christ.

Footnote: Or, their knowing you Greek, *hi'na gi·no'sko·si se*

1· Now Jesus told them, that it means everlasting life to take in knowledge of God, for there is only one true God, Yehowah, and also of his Son, Jesus Christ, for God had sent this one forth for this very purpose.

[Question] What did Jesus tell his faithful disciples that taking in true knowledge of him and his Father would give to them?

[Question] Where primarily do people get that true knowledge about Jesus Christ and Yehowah God today?

2· Now, look! A certain man versed in the Law rose up, to test him out, and said; Teacher, by doing what shall I inherit everlasting life? (**Luke 10:25**)

[Question] What did a man versed in the Law Covenant, ask of Jesus?

3· Until we all attain to the oneness in the faith, and in the accurate knowledge of the Son of God, to a full-grown man, to the measure of stature, that belongs to the fullness of the Christ. (**Ephesians 4:13**)

[Question] How many different faiths are there, and what does truly accurate knowledge, lead people to become?

[Question] Whose measure of stature do all anointed Christians seek to measure up to, and will that take time to attain to?

4· And this is what I continue praying, that your love may abound yet more and more, with accurate knowledge, and full discernment. (**Philippians 1:9**)

[Question] What did the Apostle Paul continue praying for, regarding his spirit anointed Christian brothers?

5· O Timothy, guard what is laid up in trust with you, turning away from the empty speeches that violate what is holy, and from the contradictions of the falsely called, knowledge. (**1 Timothy 6:20**)

[Question] What fine counsel did Paul give to Timothy, and what should he avoid to secure this confidence?

- 6· No, but go on growing in the undeserved kindness and **knowledge** of our Lord and Savior, **Jesus Christ**. To him be the glory, both now, and to the day of eternity. (**2 Peter 3:18**)

[Question] What did the apostle Peter want his Christian brothers to continue growing in?

- 7· Now concerning the eating of foods offered to idols, we know that an idol is nothing in the world, and that there is no **God**, but one. (**1 Corinthians 8:4**)

[Question] What did the Apostle Paul show, that an idol truly is?

- 8· For they themselves keep reporting, about the way we first entered in among you, and how you turned to **God** from your idols, to slave for a living and **true God**. (**1 Thessalonians 1:9**)

[Question] What did the Thessalonians turn away from, upon feeling the power of the true God, through his Holy Spirit operating in their lives?

- 9· But we know that the Son of **God** has come, and he has given us intellectual capacity that we may gain the **knowledge** of the **true** one. And we are in union with the **true** one, by means of his Son **Jesus Christ**. This is the **true God** and **life everlasting**. (**1 John 5:20**)

[Question] What has the Son of God given to anointed Christians, through the Holy Spirit, and what will this lead to for them?

- 10· Also, the Father who **sent** me has himself borne witness about me. You have neither heard his voice at any time nor seen his figure. (**John 5:37**)

[Question] Who also bore witness that Jesus was his son?

- 11· He is from the **God** of your father, and he will help you, and he is with the Almighty, and he will bless you with the blessings of the heavens above, with the blessings of the watery deep lying down below, with the blessings of the breasts and womb. (**Genesis 49:25**)

[Question] What blessing of Jacob, toward his son Joseph, applies to the Greater Joseph, the Messiah, Jesus Christ?

- 12· Because on me he has set his affection, I shall also provide him with escape. I shall protect him, because he has come to know my name. (**Psalms 91:14**)

[Question] Why did Yehowah God show, that he would provide his faithful son with escape from his enemies, and protect him?

- 13· To give to the inexperienced ones shrewdness, to a young man **knowledge** and thinking ability. (**Proverbs 1:4**)

[Question] What does a study of the Bible, give to even inexperienced persons?

- 14· For the one finding me, will certainly find **life**, and gets goodwill from Yehowah. (**Proverbs 8:35**)

[Question] What will the one finding wisdom, get from Yehowah God?

- 15· The fear of Yehowah is the start of wisdom, and the **knowledge** of the Most Holy One, is what understanding is. (**Proverbs 9:10**)

[Question] What is the start of wisdom, and what is true knowledge?

- 16· In the same way, do know wisdom for your soul. If you have found it, then there exists a future, and your own hope will not be cut off. (**Proverbs 24:14**)

[Question] What does the one finding wisdom have for the future, that will not be cut off?

- 17· Woe to those drawing error with ropes of untruth, and as with wagon cords sin. (**Isaiah 5:18**)

[Question] Who did Isaiah show would draw error along in a powerful way?

- 18· Because there are two bad things that my people have done. They have left even me, the source of living water, in order to hew out for themselves cisterns, broken cisterns, that cannot contain the water. (**Jeremiah 2:13**)

[Question] What two bad things did Yehowah God's people do, that caused him to leave them also?

- 19· But let the one bragging about himself, brag about himself

because of this very thing, the having of insight and the having of **knowledge** of me, that I am Yehowah, the One exercising loving-kindness, justice and righteousness in the earth, for in these things, I do take delight, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 9:24**)

[Question] What kind of bragging does Yehowah God enjoy hearing?

20· And they will no more teach each one his companion and each one his brother, saying; Know Yehowah! For they will all of them know me, from the least one of them even to the greatest one of them, is the utterance of Yehowah. For I shall forgive their error, and their sin, I shall remember no more. (**Jeremiah 31:34**)

[Question] What do all anointed Christians know, because they are all under the terms of the New Covenant?

[Question] What will Yehowah God, no more call to their account?

21· And those who are acting wickedly against the covenant, he will lead into apostasy by means of smooth words. But as regards the people who are knowing their **God**, they will prevail and act effectively. (**Daniel 11:32**)

[Question] How will Yehowah God deal with those acting against the covenant, and who will prevail effectively?

22· He said to him; You answered correctly, keep on doing this, and you will get life. (**Luke 10:28**)

[Question] What did Jesus tell a listener to do, to get life?

23· Work, not for the food that perishes, but for the food that remains for **life everlasting**, which the Son of man will give you, for upon this one, the Father, even **God**, has put his seal of approval. (**John 6:27**)

[Question] What food did Jesus tell his disciples to work hard for, for what kind of life does it lead them to?

24· Simon Peter answered him; Lord, whom shall we go away to? You have sayings of **everlasting life**. (**John 6:68**)

[Question] Why did Peter and others refuse to leave Jesus, even when he spoke in a way they could not understand at the time?

- 25· **Jesus** said to him; I am the way and the truth and the **life**. No one comes to the Father, except through me. (**John 14:6**)

[Question] What did Jesus say that he himself was, and can anyone come to the Father, Yehowah God except through him?

- 26· For **God** is he who said; Let the light shine out of darkness, and he has shone on our hearts, to illuminate them with the glorious **knowledge** of **God**, by the face of **Christ**. (**2 Corinthians 4:6**)

[Question] Who said that the light should shine out of darkness, and how did Paul apply this scripture to Christians?

- 27· In order, that you may be thoroughly able to grasp mentally with all the holy ones, what is the breadth and length and height and depth. (**Ephesians 3:18**)

[Question] What did Paul want all of his anointed Christian brothers to understand thoroughly?

- 28· For bodily training is beneficial for a little, but godly devotion is beneficial for all things, as it holds promise of the **life** now, and that which is to come. (**1 Timothy 4:8**)

[Question] What is the benefit of bodily training, when compared to spiritual training?

[Question] Why is spiritual training better?

- 29· Forasmuch as his divine power has given us freely all the things that concern **life** and godly devotion, through the accurate **knowledge** of the one who called us, through glory and virtue. (**2 Peter 1:3**)

[Question] What has the Holy Spirit given to anointed Christians, and through what?

- 30· Yes, for this very reason, by your contributing in response all earnest effort, supply to your faith virtue, to your virtue **knowledge**. (**2 Peter 1:5**)

[Question] What did Peter show, are things that can build up our faith?

- 31· Yes, the **life** was made manifest, and we have seen, and are

bearing witness, and reporting to you, the **everlasting life** which was with the Father, and was made manifest to us. **(1 John 1:2)**

[Question] What life was made manifest in Jesus Christ?

32· Furthermore, this is the promised thing that he himself promised us, the **life everlasting**. **(1 John 2:25)**

[Question] What is the promise of Yehowah God respecting life in the future?

33· Beloved ones, let us continue loving one another, because love is from **God**, and everyone who loves, has been born from **God** and gains the **knowledge of God**. **(1 John 4:7)**

[Question] Why is it so important to continue loving our brothers?

[Question] Where has everyone loving his brothers been born from?

34· And this is the witness given, that **God** gave us **everlasting life**, and this **life** is in his Son. **(1 John 5:11)**

[Question] What is the witness of God concerning the Good News?

35· Saying; Amen! The blessing and the glory, and the wisdom, and the thanksgiving, and the honor, and the power, and the strength, be to our **God** forever and ever. Amen. **(Revelation 7:12)**

[Question] What is attributed to Yehowah God, that he is deserving of forever?
