

**John 17:4~** I have glorified you on the earth, having finished the work you have given me to do.

**1·** So Jesus spoke to his heavenly Father out loud, stating that he had brought glory to his heavenly Father through his ministry on earth, and that now, he had finished that work, just as he had been commanded to do.

**[Question]** What did Jesus now say out loud directly to Yehowah God, for what had Jesus now accomplished fully?

**2·** Hence when he had gone out, Jesus said; Now the Son of man is glorified, and God is glorified in connection with him. (**John 13:31**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell his disciples, upon leaving the Memorial celebration?

**3·** Also, whatever it is that you ask in my name, I will do this, in order, that the Father may be glorified in connection with the Son. (**John 14:13**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus promise to do for his disciples once he was glorified in heaven?

**4·** Jesus said to them; My food is for me to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work. (**John 4:34**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus consider the doing of his Father's will, to be like for him?

**5·** My vows I shall pay to Yehowah, yes, in front of all his people. (**Psalms 116:14**)

**[Question]** How did the Psalmist feel about doing the things he had promised to God?

**6·** But he said to them; Let us go somewhere else, into the village towns nearby, that I may preach there also, for it is for this purpose, I have gone out. (**Mark 1:38**)

**[Question]** Why did Jesus keep moving around in his ministry to Israel?

**7·** When, now, he had received the sour wine, Jesus said; It has been accomplished! And, bowing his head, he

**delivered up his spirit. (John 19:30)**

**[Question]** What was the last thing that Jesus performed in fulfillment of prophecy, to accomplish God's word before he died?
