

John 17:6~ I have made your name manifest to the men you gave me out of the world. They were yours, and you gave them to me, and they have observed your word.

1· Then Jesus stated, that he had made God's name, Yehowah, known to the men Yehowah had given him out of the world. They were God's people, and he had given them over to the shepherding of his beloved Son, Jesus, and they had now observed his word in respect of his Son.

[Question] What name did Jesus show, that he had made known to his own disciples?

[Question] Into whose protective hand had Yehowah God given mankind over to?

2· I will declare your **name** to my brothers, in the middle of the congregation, I shall praise you. (**Psalms 22:22**)

[Question] How did the Psalmist feel, about praising his God among his fleshly brothers?

3· What my Father has given me, is something greater than all other things, and no one can snatch them **out** of the hand of the Father. (**John 10:29**)

[Question] What kind of an inheritance does Jesus have, and what is it greater than?

4· Symeon has related thoroughly how God for the first time turned his attention to the nations, to take **out** of them a people for his **name**. (**Acts of Apostles 15:14**)

[Question] Why did Yehowah God turn his attention to the nations of the earth, after his dealings with the Jews for many years?

5· As he says; I will declare your **name** to my brothers. In the middle of the congregation, I will praise you with song. (**Hebrews 2:12**)

[Question] How did Paul apply the Psalmist mentioned earlier, to the Christ?

6· And my faithfulness and my loving-kindness are with him, and in my **name** his horn is exalted. (**Psalms 89:24**)

[Question] How did the Psalmist show how Yehowah God's Messiah would act before his God, for what would Yehowah God put within him?

- 7· **For your statutes I shall show a fondness. I shall not forget your word. (Psalms 119:16)**

[Question] What did the Psalmist show a fondness for, and how did they apply to Jesus?

- 8· **I shall bow down toward your holy temple, and I shall laud your name, because of your loving-kindness, and because of your trueness. For you have magnified your saying, even above all your name. (Psalms 138:2)**

[Question] How did the Psalmist express his praise for Yehowah God?

- 9· **Everything the Father gives me will come to me, and the one that comes to me, I will by no means drive away. (John 6:37)**

[Question] Who are drawn to Jesus Christ, and who draws them?

[Question] What will Jesus Christ not do, toward anyone coming to him?

- 10· **So he went on to say to them; You are from the realms below. I am from the realms above. You are from this world. I am not from this world. (John 8:23)**

[Question] How did Jesus show how different he was from other men, for what were his origins before becoming a man?

- 11· **And I have made your name known to them, and will make it known, in order, that the love with which you loved me, may be in them, and I in union with them. (John 17:26)**

[Question] Why did Jesus make his Father's name known to his disciples, for what was dependent upon knowing it?

- 12· **I have fought the fine fight, I have run the course to the finish, I have observed the faith. (2 Timothy 4:7)**

[Question] What course did Paul show near the end of his ministry, that he had run successfully?

- 13· **They blaspheme the fine name by which you were called,**

do they not? (**James 2:7**)

[Question] What did James say, that the rich did toward faithful anointed Christians?

- 14· The one that conquers, I will make him a pillar in the temple of my God, and he will by no means go **out** from it anymore, and I will write upon him, the **name** of my God, and the **name** of the city of my God, the new Jerusalem, which descends **out** of heaven from my God, and that new **name** of mine. (**Revelation 3:12**)

[Question] What did Jesus say that he would make of the one conquering, and where would such a one reside forever, close to whom?

- 15· That people may know that you, whose name is Yehowah, you alone are the Most High over all the earth. (**Psalms 83:18**)

[Question] Who does the Psalmist say is the Most High over all the earth, and what is his name?
