John 17:8~ Because the sayings that you gave me, I have given to them, and they have received them, and have certainly come to know, that I came out as your representative, and they have believed, that you sent me forth.

1. Then Jesus showed, that the sayings he had received from his heavenly Father, he had in turn given to his disciples, and they had received them, as if coming directly from God. Therefore they had come to know, that Jesus came out as a direct representative of his heavenly Father, and believed, that Yehowah God had indeed sent Jesus forth to save them.

[Question] What had Jesus received from his Father, and how did Jesus' disciples receive this information?

2. Simon Peter answered him; Lord, whom shall we go away to? You have sayings of everlasting life. (John 6:68)

[Question] How did Peter respond when invited to leave by Jesus, after he spoke sayings that offended many?

3. Therefore Jesus said; When once you have lifted up the Son of man, then you will know that I am he, and that I do nothing of my own initiative, but just as the Father taught me, I speak these things. (John 8:28)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples that they would come to realize, only after they lifted him up in faith?

[Question] Where did all of the sayings Jesus spoke, come forth from?

4. Because I have not spoken out of my own impulse, but the Father himself who sent me, has given me a commandment, as to what to tell, and what to speak. (John 12:49)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples about where his sayings came forth from?

5. Do you not believe that I am in union with the Father, and the Father is in union with me? The things I say to you men, I do not speak of my own originality, but the Father who remains in union with me, is doing his works. (John 14:10)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples about the unity he had with Yehowah God, and where did all his sayings come forth from?

6. For the Father himself has affection for you, because you have had affection for me, and have believed, that I came out as the Father's representative. (John 16:27)

[Question] Why does the Father have affection for Jesus' disciples?

7 Consequently, holy brothers, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the apostle and High Priest whom we confess, Jesus. (Hebrews 3:1)

[Question] What should anointed Christians pay particularly close attention to, and why?

8. Now we know that you know all things, and you do not need to have anyone question you. By this, we believe, that you came out from God. (John 16:30)

[Question] What did Jesus' disciples come to believe after questioning him?

9. A prophet I shall raise up for them from the midst of their brothers, like you, and I shall indeed put my words in his mouth, and he will certainly speak to them, all that I shall command him. (Deuteronomy 18:18)

[Question] What did Yehowah God promise, through Moses, to raise up for Israel, and who would this prophet be like?

10. And they began to say to the woman; We do not believe any longer on account of your talk, for we have heard for ourselves, and we know, that this man is for a certainty, the savior of the world. (John 4:42)

[Question] What did the men of a Samaritan village testify, after hearing Jesus words for themselves?

11. True, I knew that you always hear me, but on account of the crowd standing around, I spoke, in order, that they might believe, that you sent me forth. (John 11:42)

[Question] What confidence did Jesus always have respecting his own thoughts and sayings?

12. In order, that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are

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in union with me, and I am in union with you, that they also may be in union with us, in order, that the world may believe, that you sent me forth. (John 17:21)

[Question] What kind of unity did Jesus want his disciples to have toward him and toward Yehowah God, and toward one another?
